FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PARATRANSIT FACILITY

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WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage periodically applies for and receives Federal Transit Administration grants for capital, operational and other purposes in connection with providing public transportation and related facilities; and therefore,

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The Anchorage Assembly resolves:

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That the Administration is authorized to accept a Federal Transit Administration FY2005 Section 5309 Bus and Bus-Related Earmark allocations grant.

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Section 2. That the sum of One Million Four Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$1,457,667) is hereby accepted and appropriated to Public Transportation Capital Fund (485) as a grant from the Federal Transit Administration to fund the construction of a Paratransit operations center at 3650 E. Tudor Road.

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Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Municipal Assembly of Anchorage.

Accepting and appropriating a Federal Transit Administration FY2005

Section 5309 Bus and Bus-Related Earmark allocations grant Project No. E2005-BUSP-003 that provides Federal capital assistance in the amount

of \$1,457,667.

The funds will be expended for the construction of a Paratransit Operations Center at 3650 E. Tudor Road Transit Campus.

Plans and specifications for a design/build contract have been developed to construct a new office addition and remodel the Old People Mover Shop to accommodate a new facility to house the AnchorRIDES system, located on the People Mover campus. The functions that will be accommodated in these facilities include operations, maintenance, administration, driver locker and break rooms, and scheduling and dispatching.

The project consists of the design and construction of a 7,725 sq. ft. two-story office building integrated and connected to the northwest portion of the old People Mover Shop. The old People Mover Shop is approximately 22,386 sq. ft. and has five bays one of which includes a wash bay located at the west end. The wash bay is adjacent to the proposed administration office addition and a portion of the wash bay will be remodeled to include a new two story maintenance and parts office interconnected to the new office addition. The remaining portion of the bay will remain as a wash bay. Installation of automatic washing equipment is planned at a future date. A fire sprinkler system will be installed throughout the old People Mover Shop and new office addition. The project includes all of the site work and utilities necessary to support its development. The proposed office building site and the old shop have been reviewed and analyzed to study and scope hazmat potential, structural integrity, mechanical and electrical system conditions, and necessary fire code upgrades.

The required local match \$364,417 will be provided from 2005 General Obligations Bonds approved by voters in April 2005.
