A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED FIFTY SIX THOUSAND TEN DOLLARS (\$256,010) AS A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND APPROPRIATING FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$5,450) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE 2006 ANCHORAGE POLICE OPERATING BUDGET, ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231), ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE OF TERRORISM RESPONSE AND PREVENTION EQUIPMENT.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY SIX THOUSAND TEN DOLLARS (\$256,010) is appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Police Department, for the purchase of terrorism response and prevention equipment.


Section 2. That the sum of FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$5,450) is appropriated from the 2006 Anchorage Police Operating Budget, Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151) as a contribution to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Police Department, for the purchase of terrorism response and prevention equipment.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

**Subject:** Appropriation of State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management State Homeland Security, Reallocated FY2004 State Homeland Security Program Grant Funding (\$261,460)

The Municipality of Anchorage, Anchorage Police Department has received from the Office for Domestic Preparedness through the State of Alaska, reallocated FY2004 State Homeland Security Program grant funding to enhance security and preparedness for terrorist prevention. Appropriation of grant and required local matching funds is requested to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

Grant funds awarded provide for the procurement of specialized terrorism response equipment, search and rescue equipment and supply items to be utilized by the Anchorage Police Department.

Reallocated FY2004 State Homeland Security Program Grant funds will be administered by the Anchorage Police Department. A special condition of this grant is that the department contribute funds to support associated indirect grant costs. The total projected municipal cost is \$5,450 which is funded through a 2006 operating contribution from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151). This grant began on May 5, 2004 and will end on November 30, 2006.
