1 AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE TALUS
2 WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA (LRSA) AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL
3 ELECTION ON APRIL 4, 2006, A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO EXTEND THE TALUS
4 WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA (LRSA) FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE YEARS
5 AND AMEND ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.30.200.

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8 WHEREAS, the Talus West Limited Road Service Area (LRSA) was created by Anchorage
9 Ordinance 79-234; and

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11 WHEREAS, a showing of interest in extending the Talus West LRSA has been made by the
12 residents of the LRSA; and

14 WHEREAS, the Talus West LRSA Board of Supervisors recommends the extension of the LRSA
15 for three additional years; now therefore,

18 THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

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20 **Section 1.** Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Charter 9.01(a), a ballot proposition in
21 substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Talus
22 West LRSA at the regular Municipal election April 4, 2006:

26 APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD
27 SERVICE AREA FOR THREE ADDITIONAL YEARS.

29 Shall the Talus West Limited Road Service Area be extended for three additional
30 years until December 31, 2009?

35 **Section 2.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.30.200 is hereby amended as follows:

37 27.30.200 Talus West Road Limited Road Service Area

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39 There is established a limited road service area within the municipality known as the Talus
40 West Limited Road Service Area (TWLRSA) as depicted on the map located in section
41 27.30.700. The Talus West Limited Road Service Area shall provide limited road
42 maintenance within the service area commencing on January 1, 1980, and ceasing on
43 December 31, 2009 [2006], unless extended by an affirmative vote in the area affected at

1 the regular election of April 2009 [2006]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.30 mills in any
2 calendar year.

9 **Section 3.** Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and
10 approval of the Anchorage Municipal Assembly. Section 2 and the proposition contained in
11 Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called
12 for by this ordinance, but only if the proposition is approved by the majority of the qualified voters
13 voting on the proposition.
