AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.05.035 TO REQUIRE MEMBERS OF MUNICIPAL ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OTHER THAN THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION TO BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Anchorage Municipal Code section4.05.035 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. follows:

4.05.035 Qualifications of members.

In addition to any other qualifications required by this Code, a board or commission member shall:

- A. If legally eligible, be a qualified voter of the municipality;
- B. Maintain domicile in the municipality while in office;
- C. If serving on an advisory, adjudicatory or regulatory board, be at least 18 years of age, unless serving as a youth advisory member specifically designated under municipal code for an advisory board or commission, or as an ad hoc nonvoting member: and
- D. If under 18 years of age and serving as a youth advisory member specifically designated under municipal code for [ON] an advisory board or commission, meet the state requirements relating to employment of minors during the member's service on the board or commission.

Section 2. Upon passage and approval of this ordinance, any current member under the age of 18 of an advisory board or commission, who is not serving as a youth advisory member specifically authorized to be under the age of 18 under AMC 4.60.085B for the Mt. View Community Recreation Center Advisory Commission

AO 2007-24 — AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.05.035 TO REQUIRE MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OTHER THAN THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMISSION TO BE AT

LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.

In this city, we recognize that young people bring diverse viewpoints to issues that affect them, their future, and the city. We are a youthful city and by engaging our youth, we encourage civic responsibility and make an investment in our future. Youth participation can also assist by involving the powerful informal networks unique to youth. That is one purpose of the Youth Advisory Commission. Created to encourage participation in "issues, services and programs" and to advise the municipality on issues from the frame of reference that spans 14 to 22 years of age, the Youth Advisory Commission was created by code and is specifically designed under AMC 4.60.275 to draw membership from our youth. The same is true of the youth designated member of the Mt. View Community Recreation Center Advisory Commission under AMC 4.60.085B.

The proposed ordinance does not change the status of membership on the Youth Advisory Commission or the status of any youth designated seat created by code for advisory boards or commissions. The proposed ordinance changes AMC 4.05.035 to ensure that members of advisory boards and commissions will be at least 18 years of age when appointed to serve the municipality, unless a youth designated membership has been created in municipal code. This matches the legal voting age of 18.

Permitting the appointment of minors under the age of 18 to serve as equal voting members on all advisory boards and commissions without a designated youth seat or membership "jumps the gun" in terms of experience and expertise in life and decision-making that we demand of our advisory boards and commissions. Where code does not provide for a youth member, the youth perspective, commitment, and mentorship can be invited and accomplished better through ad hoc nonvoting membership.
