WHEREAS, pursuant to Anchorage Ordinance 90-71(S), Ruth Arcand Park is dedicated to park and recreational uses, and the lease of dedicated municipal park land must be

approved by the voters of the Municipality of Anchorage pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Charter §10.02(8) and Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.020;

WHEREAS, a companion ordinance, Anchorage Ordinance 2007-26, contains a ballot proposition to the voters, as required by Anchorage Municipal Charter §10.02(8) and Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.020, subject to approval of the non-exclusive, long-term lease described herein; now therefore,

# THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Assembly hereby approves a non-exclusive, long-term lease between the Municipality and the Rainbow Connection Therapeutic Riding Program and Anchorage Horse Council for the Section 16 Equestrian Center, also known as the William Clark Chamberlin Equestrian Center, consisting of approximately 334.57 acres located in Ruth Arcand Park, more particularly described as Tract D, Section 16 Subdivision, according to Plat 86-724, located within the Anchorage Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska. The essential terms and conditions of the lease are summarized in the Assembly Memorandum submitted with this ordinance.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Assembly specifically finds the disposal of municipal land by non-exclusive, long-term lease at less than fair market value to the Rainbow Connection and Anchorage Horse Council, two non-profit corporations, allows the use of the land for a public purpose beneficial to the Municipality, as required by Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.040.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval, subject to approval of ballot proposition contained in the companion ordinance referenced above.

AND THE ANCHORAGE HORSE COUNCIL, INC.

The Anchorage Horse Council, Inc., a non-profit corporation, manages the Section 16 Equestrian Center (Center), also known as the William Clark Chamberlin Equestrian Center, located in a portion of Ruth Arcand Park, under a management agreement administered by the Department of Parks and Recreation since 1985. The Center serves the community as an equestrian recreation area.

The Rainbow Connection (Rainbow), a Therapeutic Horseback Riding Program, needs a permanent, handicapped accessible facility in order to continue to serve people in Anchorage who live with disabilities. Rainbow has struggled for years seeking private barn owners to host their program but the program is at risk each time a barn and/or indoor riding stable is sold or circumstances change. However, the population served by Rainbow Connection remains and the waiting list grows each year as individuals wait to take part in the program.

The Anchorage Horse Council and Rainbow Connection have joined forces in an effort to obtain a non-exclusive, long term lease at Ruth Arcand Park, providing each entity with the opportunity to raise and invest private funds for designing handicapped accessible facilities and other improvements at the Center, and for the benefit of the Municipality and the public. These facilities and improvements benefit Alaskans with physical disabilities and aide further development and enhancement of the Center facilities.

The Anchorage Horse Council and Rainbow Connection agree to operate the Center in partnership by proposing a non-exclusive, long term lease of the Center, for a term not to exceed 20 years, plus two additional 10 year renewal options, at less than fair market value. The land included in the lease consists of approximately 334.57 acres in Ruth Arcand Park, Tract D, Section 16 Subdivision, Plat No. 86-824. Pursuant to Anchorage Ordinance 90-71(S), Ruth Arcand Park is dedicated to park and recreational uses, and a lease of municipal park land requires approval by the voters under Anchorage Municipal Charter §10.02(8) and Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.020.
