AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.20.090, CHUGIAK FIRE SERVICE AREA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, TO SPECIFY CERTAIN DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND PRIORITY CONSISTENT WITH SUPERVISION AND OVERSIGHT BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.20.090, Chugiak Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors, is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.20.090 Chugiak Fire Service Area board of supervisors.

- A. There is established a board of supervisors for the Chugiak Fire Service Area consisting of three persons elected in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. The board shall be constituted and shall function in the manner prescribed in this chapter.
- B. The board's duties and responsibilities include the following:
1. The board shall oversee the provision of fire services in the Chugiak Fire Service Area.
 2. The board shall oversee and provide for the maintenance and repair of fire service vehicles and equipment on behalf of the Chugiak Fire Service Area.
 3. The board shall prepare and submit an annual budget to the municipal administration and the assembly for approval.
 4. The board shall administer contracts entered into on behalf of the Chugiak Fire Service Area.
 5. The board shall represent the Chugiak Fire Service Area in the use of Chugiak Fire Service Area resources in the delivery of area wide

emergency medical services managed by the Anchorage Fire Department.

6. The board shall oversee the participation of the Chugiak Fire Service Area in intra-governmental arrangements for mutual-aid and other cooperation agreements.

C. It shall be a priority of the Chugiak Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors to support and maintain Chugiak Volunteer Fire & Rescue Co., Inc. as the primary emergency service provider within the Chugiak Fire Service Area. The administration of the municipality shall not prescribe rules, procedures or guidelines to be followed in furnishing services or expending moneys that interfere with this priority unless mandated by law or emergency.



Subject: AO 2007- 49 — AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING AMC SECTION 27.20.090, CHUGIAK FIRE SERVICE AREA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, TO SPECIFY CERTAIN DUTIES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND PRIORITY CONSISTENT WITH SUPERVISION AND OVERSIGHT BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

The Chugiak Fire Service Area (CFSA) exists within the municipality to provide fire protection services to the area's residents. It is a legal entity defined under Section 9.01 of the Charter and funded by a mill rate approved by qualified residents of the service area. The service area has existed since 1968 before unification of the Municipality with the Greater Anchorage Area Borough. The boundaries of its jurisdiction are outlined in the map at AMC 27.30.060. The Fire Service area is served by over 70 volunteers now organized and incorporated as the Chugiak Fire & Rescue Company, Inc., available for service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 52 weeks a year. It is the largest volunteer fire and rescue department in Alaska and operates five station houses. The volunteers began as a territorial fire department over 54 years ago, meet all established training and safety guidelines, and have been active and vital every year since that time. The Chugiak Fire Service Area is governed by a board of supervisors (BOS) comprised of three elected members. This board is established and guided by AMC section 27.20.090.

The attached Assembly Ordinance 2007-49 adds additional sections to this chapter in order to further clarify the duties and responsibilities of the Board of Supervisors. This ordinance supplies clearer guidance and more appropriate chapter language that was omitted when the original language was adopted.

The elected members of the Board of Supervisors for the Chugiak Fire Service Area support this enhancement to AMC and we join them in urging approval of AO-2007-49 as submitted.
