AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S DISPOSAL BY DEMOLITION OF THE CURRENT CLARK MIDDLE SCHOOL BUILDING

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code 25.30.020 provides that the municipality may dispose of municipal land or any interest therein only by ordinance.

WHEREAS, in April 2007 the voters approved funding for the Clark Middle School Replacement project.

 WHEREAS, the School Board approved the Schematic Design for Clark Middle School Replacement project on December 4, 2006 (ASD Memorandum #128, 2006-2007) and the Anchorage Assembly approved the Revised (Schematic) Design for the Clark Middle School Replacement project on January 23, 2007 (AR-2006-314 (s), AM 877-2006 (A)).

WHEREAS, the replacement school is currently in final design and is anticipated to start construction in this summer of 2007 and to be completed August 2009.

WHEREAS, retaining much of the existing school has been studied extensively, and these studies have supported demolition of the building;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to demolish the current building in order to construct the new Clark Middle School.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly ordains:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the School District's proposal to demolish the current building at Clark Middle School is approved in order to clear the site for the construction of the Clark Middle School Replacement building.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
