AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.10.020, REVIEW AND CERTIFICATION OF LICENSE APPLICATIONS AND SECTION 17.15.070, SPECIAL PURPOSE LICENSING PROCEDURES FOR MULTI-ANIMAL AND COMMERCIAL FACILITY LICENSES, TO PROVIDE THAT A VALID BUSINESS LICENSE MAY BE REVOKED AND RENEWAL MAY BE DENIED IF VIOLATION OF LAND USE UNDER TITLE 21 ENDANGERS PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY; AND AMENDING SECTION 21.25.020, INVALID LAND USE ENTITLEMENTS, TO CLARIFY APPLICATION OF PROHIBITIONS AGAINST ISSUANCE OF LAND USE ENTITLEMENTS UNDER TITLE 21.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 10.10.020 is hereby amended to read as follows: (subsections not affected are not set out except for context)

10.10.020 Review and certification of license applications; issuance of licenses.

- A. Upon receipt of an application which meets the requirements of Section 10.10.015, the municipal clerk shall:
- 1. Circulate the application among the following municipal departments and officials and request that the application be reviewed to determine whether the proposed activity or business complies with the specific laws or municipal regulations administered and enforced by such departments and officials:
 - d. Building official, if the proposed business or activity will be operated within premises or a structure to which municipal ordinances and regulations enforced by the building official, including building, life safety and zoning ordinances, apply. Certifications under this subsection shall be based on actual inspection of the premises or activity described in the license application. Violation of land use ordinance and regulation under Title 21 shall not be cause to revoke or deny renewal of a license under 10.10.030 unless the violation endangers

 the public health and safety. If inspection results in a determination that the land use violation endangers the public health and safety, the certification under this subsection shall include the factual basis for the determination. This subsection shall not prevent an enforcement action of land use ordinance and regulation for any violation.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 17.15.070 is hereby amended to read as follows: (subsections not affected are not set out)

17.15.070 Special purpose licensing procedures for multi-animal and commercial facility licenses.

- A. Application for a special purpose license is made to the animal care and control center. The application shall include:
 - [5. NOTIFICATION THAT THE <u>special purpose</u> LICENSE <u>is subject to revocation or denial as set out in this chapter</u> [SHALL ONLY BE ISSUED IF THE APPLICANT IS IN COMPLIANCE, AND REMAINS IN COMPLIANCE, WITH ZONING REQUIREMENTS, HUMANE ANIMAL KEEPING, BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIREMENTS, AND ALL OTHER LAWS UNDER THIS TITLE AS APPLICABLE];]

Section 3. Anchorage Municipal Code section 21.25.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

21.25.020 Invalid land use entitlements.

A. No entitlement may be issued under this title unless all structures and uses of land and structures permitted under the entitlement conform to this title, the regulations promulgated under this title and the terms and conditions of the other entitlements issued under this title that apply to the use or structure. An entitlement issued in violation of this section is void.

B. The prohibition in 21.25.020A shall not apply to nonconforming characteristics of use under this title. Consideration of characteristics of use in relation to the issuance of an entitlement shall comply with 21.55.100.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
