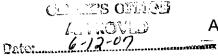

AN ORDINANCE CREATING HIGHLAND-2 SANITARY SEWER LATERAL SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT 1760, AND DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT:

- The Municipality has been petitioned to create a special assessment district for the A. construction of sanitary sewer improvements described in paragraph "C" below, within the area described in paragraph "D" below;
- The petition to create the special assessment district has been signed by sufficient B. and proper owners and has been filed with the Municipal Clerk;
- The sanitary sewer improvements include all necessary sanitary sewer main C. piping and appurtenances required to serve the area described in paragraph "D" below and as shown on the attached map;
- The sanitary sewer improvements described above are necessary and will benefit D. the following described property which will be assessed for said improvements:

Birch Trail Subdivision - TR A: Highland Subdivision - Block 1 Lots 2 - 8; Highland Subdivision - Block 2 Lots 1 - 8; T12N R3W SEC 20 - N2N2SW4NW4SW4; T12N R3W SEC 20 - S2N2SW4NW4SW4 PARCEL 20; T12N R3W SEC 20 - TR B REM;

The total cost of the proposed sanitary sewer improvement is estimated at E. \$1,004,853.06. Said estimated cost will be prorated by the benefited area assessment methodology as delineated in the Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff, as supported by sufficient and proper owners, and as shown on the attached preliminary assessment roll; now, therefore,

41 42 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

There is established Highland-2 Sanitary Sewer Lateral Special Assessment District 1760, consisting of the area described in paragraph "D" above.

The Municipality shall proceed with the proposed Sanitary Sewer Section 2. improvements as described.

Section 3. An account shall be kept of all costs of the proposed improvements.

After the improvements have been completed and the cost of the Section 4. improvements known, the Mayor shall prepare a final assessment roll for this sewer special assessment district.

The authorized percentage of the cost, or rate to be assessed against the Section 5. property, shall be computed in accordance with the Anchorage Municipal Code and Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff in effect at the time the assessment roll is approved by the Municipal Assembly. Costs shall be assessed to benefited property in the sanitary sewer special assessment district by the benefited area assessment method prescribed in the Tariff, such that a benefited parcel's pro rata share of the costs shall be computed by multiplying the total assessed project cost by a fraction determined by dividing the benefited area of the parcel by the total benefited area for the improvement. Additionally, a Special Assessment Collection Charge as authorized by the Municipal Code and Wastewater Utility Tariff will be charged annually to each active account.

The Mayor shall cause this ordinance to be recorded in the office of the Anchorage District Recorder.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.

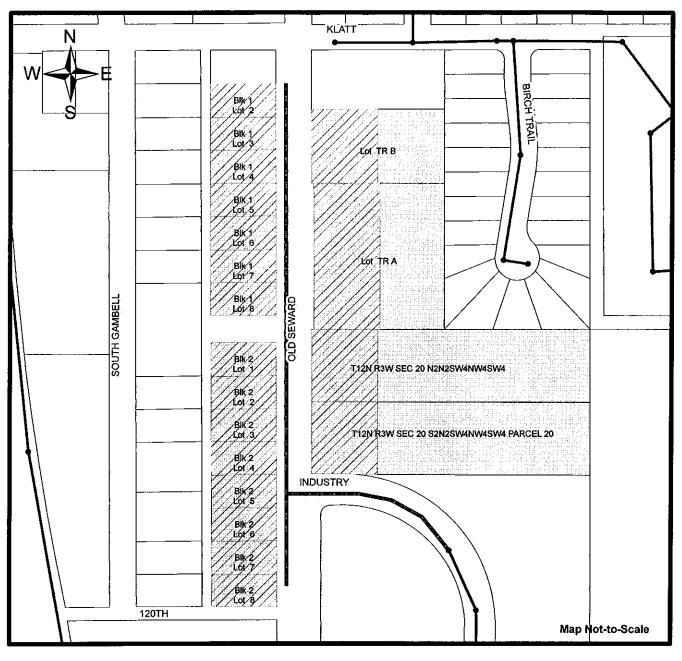

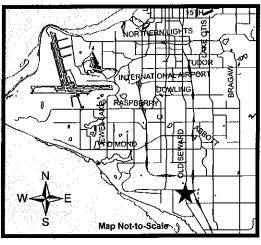

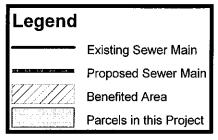
Public Sector Economic Effects: The Utility anticipates installation of the improvement in 2008 in coordination with an Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities highway reconstruction project. Annual projected revenue and interest earnings for this project equal \$ 30,713.12 estimated from 2009 forward. Total projected operational and interest expense is also estimated to be \$ 30,713.12, the net effect being zero (\$0.00). This sewer extension is viewed as immaterial to the operational cost to the Utility, being a negligible increase.

Private Sector Economic Effects: The benefited properties will be assessed a special assessment for construction of the improvement. See attached preliminary assessment roll (AO). The Utility will finance the cost of the improvement for up to twenty years.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING HIGHLAND-2 SANITARY SEWER LATERAL SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT 1760, AND DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN.

This ordinance supports creation of Highland-2 Sanitary Sewer Lateral Special Assessment District 1760. The proposed sanitary sewer lateral special assessment district (LID) is located in South Anchorage, on Old Seward Highway between Klatt Road and Industry Way. The estimated cost to construct this LID is \$1,004,853.06, which includes all necessary piping and appurtenances required for an approved public sanitary sewer system.

 This special assessment district, benefiting nineteen (19) properties, was petition initiated. Property owners first voted by majority to allocate improvement district costs by benefited area assessment methodology.

On a second ballot allocating estimated costs by the selected benefited area assessment methodology, property owners who will bear more than fifty percent (50%) of the estimated assessable cost of the improvement voted to create this district:

FOR CREATION: 87.59%
AGAINST CREATION: 8.56%
NONRESPONSIVE: 3.85%
TOTAL: 100.00%

 The area served by this proposed sanitary sewer improvement district is presently being served by individual on-site wastewater disposal systems.

Informal public meetings were conducted at Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility's headquarters building at 3000 Arctic Boulevard for each ballot referenced above. All questions asked were answered.

The passage of this ordinance has no fiscal impact on Municipal owned properties.
