AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 25.60.100 REGARDING THE ANCHORAGE MEMORIAL PARK CEMETERY PERPETUAL MAINTENANCE NON-EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.60.100 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. follows:

### Cemetery perpetual maintenance non-expendable trust fund. 25.60.100

- There is hereby established fund 0720, designated the cemetery perpetual A. maintenance non-expendable trust fund, for the purpose of providing funding for the future maintenance of the Anchorage Memorial Park Cemetery beginning when the cemetery reaches capacity and user fee revenues cease.
- Definitions: In this section, the following definitions shall apply: B.
  - Perpetual maintenance shall mean the cutting of all grass at reasonable <u>1.</u> intervals, the raking and cleaning of grave lots and grounds, the periodic pruning of trees and shrubs and attending to the general care, maintenance and preservation of all grave lots and cemetery grounds so the property described in 25.60.010 shall remain and be reasonably cared for as cemetery grounds forever.
  - Perpetual maintenance exceptions. Perpetual maintenance shall not 2. include the maintenance, repair or replacement of any grave stones, grave markers, monumental structures or memorials placed or erected on any grave lot or cemetery grounds including those erected on any private tract(s), nor the planting of flowers or ornamental structures, nor the maintenance or doing of any special or unusual work in the cemetery. NOTE: Grave markers and headstones are considered personal property and as such may be eligible for coverage by a homeowner/renter insurance policy.
  - Annual expenditure. The annual expenditure shall be applied to lots, <u>3.</u> graves and any space within the confines of the cemetery, and shall be

limited to no more than five percent of the perpetual maintenance non-expendable trust fund's market value averaged over the previous five years. This limitation does not restrict the expenditure of other sources of income for perpetual maintenance.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.

SECTION 25.60.100 REGARDING THE ANCHORAGE MEMORIAL PARK CEMETERY PERPETUAL MAINTENANCE NON-

EXPENDABLE TRUST FUND.

A Perpetual Maintenance Non-Expendable Trust Fund was established in 1997 to maintain the cemetery grounds once the grounds are full and no revenues are coming in. A review revealed there was no explanation of exactly what perpetual maintenance covers as it pertains to the Anchorage Memorial Park Cemetery. Many cemetery rules and regulations across the country were researched by the Anchorage Memorial Park Cemetery Advisory Board, as well as the cemetery staff, and both recommend the amendments in this ordinance, defining exactly what the income generated by the perpetual maintenance non-expendable trust fund will be spent for and also indicating the grounds will be maintained as a cemetery in perpetuity.

A common misconception many people have with regards to cemetery perpetual maintenance is it includes everything in the cemetery, including family markers and headstones. This is not true, as the Municipality of Anchorage cannot be responsible for the many and varied memorials, monuments, headstones and markers throughout the cemetery forever and ever. The perpetual maintenance exceptions definition details the maintenance not covered by 'perpetual maintenance'. It should also be noted that section 25.60.085I. also discusses events beyond the control of the cemetery: "Reasonable care of the cemetery property, including markers, memorials crypts, and urns, is subject to the exclusion of acts of God, vandalism, fire, or other occurrences beyond the control of the cemetery." Naturally, the Municipality is responsible for replacement or repair of damage caused by cemetery personnel while mowing the grounds or other actions. A detailed investigation by the National Catholic Cemetery Conference, a large national cemetery organization, and review of some prominent insurance companies reveals headstones and markers are considered private property, automatically covered by most private homeowner or renter insurance policies.

The last section of this change pertains to the expenditures from the Perpetual Maintenance Non-Expendable Trust Fund. In order for the fund to be truly "perpetual", there should be some form of inflation proofing. The Percent of Market Value method is used to inflation proof the fund. This is not to say other sources of income could not be used to provide cemetery perpetual maintenance.
