1 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 1.15, CODE
2 OF ETHICS AND CHAPTER 27.20, SUPERVISORY BOARDS, TO AUTHORIZE
3 ELECTED SERVICE AREA BOARD MEMBERS TO HOLD OTHER COMPENSATED
4 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OR THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
5 SUBJECT TO THE CODE OF ETHICS.

7 WHEREAS, § 17.04(a) of the Anchorage Charter and 1.15.035H. prohibit elected
8 officials from holding municipal employment except where authorized by ordinance; and
9

10 WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 27.20, Supervisory Boards, provides
11 for both appointed Service Area Board membership and elected Service Area Board
12 membership; and

14 WHEREAS, appointed Service Area Board members are not prohibited from holding
15 employment with the municipality or the Anchorage School District; now, therefore,

17 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

19 **Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 1.15.025I.5. of the Code of Ethics is
20 hereby amended as follows (*the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore*
21 *not set out*):

23 **1.15.025 Additional provisions for municipal employees.**

24 *** **

25 I. *Political activity.* The following limitations shall apply to political
26 activity:

28 5. A municipal employee shall not serve as a member of the
29 Anchorage assembly or school board or in elective office of
30 the [AN ELECTED OFFICIAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OR
31 OTHER LOCAL.] state, [OR] federal, or another local
32 government. A municipal employee who is elected to one of
33 these [MUNICIPAL OR OTHER LOCAL, STATE OR
34 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT] offices shall resign immediately
35 from municipal employment.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.20.010, governing membership of Supervisory Boards, is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.20.010 Membership.

A. Unless otherwise provided by the ordinance establishing a board of supervisors for a service area, the board for the service area shall be composed of three members residing [ENT] within the service area appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the assembly and having the powers and duties provided in this chapter.

B. Members, whether elected or appointed, are authorized to hold other compensated employment with the municipality or the Anchorage School District, provided that the contemporaneous municipal service and employment shall not adversely affect the employee's availability, productivity, or independence of judgment in performing municipal duties.

C. An employee of the municipality or the Anchorage School District who also serves as a Service Area Board member is subject to provisions of the Code of Ethics governing both a municipal employee and [provisions] governing a member of the service board, whether [either] appointed or elected.

Section 3. The Code Revisor is directed to incorporate a cross-reference to Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.20.010 under the provisions of **section [AMC] 1.15.035H₂**, restrictions on other public employment for elected officials.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
