AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 17.10.010, ANIMALS IN PUBLIC PLACES, TO PROHIBIT DOGS IN MUNICIPAL ENCLOSED BALLFIELDS; AND AMENDING 17.70.020, CIVIL PENALTIES FOR ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL VIOLATIONS, TO ESTABLISH AN ENHANCED FINE FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROHIBITION.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 17.10.010, Animals in Public Places, is hereby amended to read as follows: (Subsections set out and not amended included for context only)

17.10.010 Animals in public places.

- B. A sport league or association having maintenance authority over an enclosed ballfield is authorized to prohibit dogs from the enclosed ballfield during the period between April 1 and September 30 by posting signage of the prohibition. Dogs shall be are prohibited from the all municipal enclosed ballfields posted in accordance with this subsection and [.] it shall be is unlawful for an owner or custodian of a dog to permit a dog to be within a municipal enclosed ballfield in violation of the signage at any time. For purposes of this prohibition, an enclosed ballfield shall mean a baseball diamond and surrounding outfield area within perimeter fencing.
- C. Posted signage notwithstanding, the municipality may issue a permit for use of the fenced ball fields for dog races, dog shows and other similar events. For event use between April 1 and September 30, permits are subject to a priority in favor of baseball and softball users and may be issued only to an organization after submission of a clean-up plan, satisfactory to the municipality, along with any deposit or fee required for the permit.

<u>Section 2.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 17.70.020, Civil Penalties for Animal Care and Control Violations, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 17.70.020 Civil penalties for animal care and control violations.

A. In addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person who violates any of the following provisions shall be subject to the applicable civil penalties stated below:

## TABLE INSET:

Anchorage Municipal Code Provision	Civil Penalty
17.10.010 <u>A.</u> Animals in public places	\$75 first violation; \$100 second violation and \$150 for third and subsequent violations.
17.10.010B. Dogs in posted ballfields April 1– September 30	\$150.00 first violation; \$ 300.00 second violation and \$ 450.00 for third and subsequent violations

- B. A person who fails to resolve a notice of violation (NOV) issued for a violation of any provision of this title within the time stated on the NOV shall be subject to a civil penalty in the amount of \$25.00, in addition to any other penalty provided by law.
- C. If an agency is required to collect any outstanding money due the municipality, a collection fee shall be added, in addition to any other fees and penalties, in an amount not to exceed 40 percent of the debt.
