1 AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 25.25, SCHOOL SITE SELECTION AND ACQUISITION SCHOOL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION, AND AMENDING 2 SECTIONS 21.15.015 AND 25.40.015 TO PROVIDE A SITE SELECTION, SITE PLAN 3 4 REVIEW AND ACQUISITION PROCESS FOR SCHOOL LANDS. 5 6 WHEREAS, the Anchorage School Board reviewed AO 2007-124(S) at its regularly 7 scheduled meeting on September 24, 2007; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Anchorage School Board unanimously approved AO 2007-124(S), subject to the following clarifying amendments: 10 11 12 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS: 13 14 Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 25.25, School Site Selection and 15 Acquisition School Building Construction, is repealed in its entirety. A copy of chapter 25.25 is attached hereto as Exhibit A. 16 17 18 Section 2. 3 [2]. Land identification.

- a. Following a determination of need by the Anchorage school district, and approval by the Anchorage school board, the school district shall make a request in writing to the Heritage Land Bank to identify municipal lands available for use as potential school sites.
 - [<u>If land held in inventory meets the need of the Anchorage school district, it shall be formally designated by resolution as school lands.</u>]
- b. If no land available in inventory meets the need of the school district, the municipality <u>may</u> [shall] utilize <u>any</u> method set out in chapter 25.20 to identify and acquire property for potential school sites.
 - [<u>Upon acquisition and compensation as described in this section, the property shall be formally designated as school lands and management authority shall be delegated to the school district.</u>]
- c. <u>Such acquisitions shall be available for consideration as potential school sites, subject to section 21.15.015.</u>
 - [A formal designation of property as school land may be removed by memorandum submitted jointly by the administration and the school district, and compensation as described in this section. The removal of a designation does not prohibit later re-designation upon school district request.]
- d. Upon assembly designation of a school site, and compensation as described in this section, management authority shall be delegated to the school district.
- 4 [3]. Compensation. At the time of delegation of management authority, Heritage Land Bank shall provide the mayor and school district an accounting showing all costs and fees associated with the land acquisition, including whether the costs were paid by the school district or by the municipality.
 - a. Notwithstanding the disposal provisions in section 25.40.025, the school district shall pay the Heritage Land Bank for all land acquisition costs incurred by the

municipality, except the assembly may, in its discretion, 1 2 waive some or all of the acquisition costs. [+] 3 In the event the actual land acquisition costs and fees 4 5 substantially exceed the market value, the assembly may, 6 in its discretion, waive some or all of the acquisition costs 7 to reduce the cost to market value. 8 9 b. Compensation may occur by cash payment, exchange, 10 credit, or any combination thereof, as mutually agreed between Heritage Land Bank and the school district, 11 and approved by the assembly. 12 13 14 Payment shall occur by: 15 Appropriation of funds from the school district to the Heritage Land Bank at the time of 16 17 designation as school land and delegation of management authority; or 18 By dedication of bond revenue approved by the 19 20 voters. 21 Lands determined by the school district and approved by the 22 <u>5.</u> school board to be excess to school needs shall be returned to 23 the Heritage Land Bank inventory, upon assembly approval 24 25 and compensation to the school district pursuant to this section. 26 27 The municipality and school district shall work together to prepare and 28 Section 4. 29 maintain internal procedures for implementation of this ordinance. 30 31 On or before December 1, 2007: The municipality, in coordination with the Anchorage school district, 32 shall compile a list of municipal land available or potentially 33 appropriate for school lands or under the management authority of the 34 35 school district. The list shall identify each parcel by tax number and size, and indicate whether improvements currently exist or are 36 designed for the parcel. 37 The list shall be submitted to the Assembly under an Assembly 38 39 Informational Memorandum (AIM) within 30 days of completion. c. Thereafter, municipality and school district shall annually review and 40 update the list of school lands; a copy shall be provided to the Assembly 41 42 by AIM in January of each year. 43
