### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 24.75.010 is hereby amended to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

### **<u>24.75.010</u>** Definitions.

C. Vendor means a person engaged in the business of offering goods or services to the public as [ROVING VENDOR OR AS] a sidewalk vendor.

A. The right-of-way division shall have authority to issue sidewalk vendor permits to allow[ING] the use of a public place for vending activity.

## 24.75.040 Sidewalk vendor permits-Bidding and award.

B. Permits shall be valid from April 1 through <u>December</u> [OCTOBER] 1 of each calendar year. <u>An Invitation to Bid shall be issued</u> [BIDS SHALL BE AWARDED] no later than March 1 of each year.

E. A list of the <u>bidder's</u> [HIDDERS'] names shall be compiled by the purchasing department and preserved. In the event additional sites become available, or an applicant fails to meet the licensing requirements by April 1 of the permit year, bidders who were not awarded a permit may be contacted, in order according to original bid, from this list until a vendor accepts the site.

Section 5. Anchorage Municipal Code section 24.75.090 is hereby amended to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

### 24.75.090 Insurance.

Before any permit is issued for a vendor, the applicant shall <u>obtain insurance</u> as listed below and furnish one or more policies or certificates of liability insurance and workers' compensation insurance issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the state and reflecting the applicable coverage. The Municipality of Anchorage shall be named as an additional insured on all liability policies.

Section 6. The sunset provision in Anchorage Ordinance 2005-160, section 11, terminating the sidewalk vendor program effective November 1, 2007, is hereby repealed.

In 2006, several changes were instituted including moving from a lottery system to a process allowing for sealed bids to obtain a vendor location. Over the last two years the municipality collected around \$78,000 plus several thousand dollars in permit fees. Previously the same program over the course of 2 years brought in about \$7,000.

When the code changes were made in 2006, sunset language was included that schedules

the program to end altogether on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007.

For two years the program has been administered by the Purchasing Department and enforced by Municipal Right-of-Way. While the MOA continues to work to make the 23 program better, the current system is fairer, easier to enforce and better for downtown 24 overall. The MOA will continue to work with the Anchorage Downtown Partnership to 25 address issues as they arise, and to strike a balance between small temporary business 26

The ordinance includes some needed technical changes to the code, plus the ordinance repeals the sunset provision in Section 11 of AO 2005-160, allowing the program to continue.
