Shall the existence of the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area be continued until altered or abolished by an affirmative vote of the majority of qualified voters in the area affected?

<u>Section 2.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.30.370 is amended to read as follows:

27.30.370 Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area.

- A. There is established, pursuant to Section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service area within the municipality to be known as Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area of the municipality, as outlined on the map located in Section 27.30.700.
- B. The Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for maintenance of roads and snow plowing, and shall continue in existence until altered or abolished [COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 1989, AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 2009, UNLESS THE SERVICE AREA IS EXTENDED] by an affirmative vote of the area affected at an election held prior to alteration or abolishment of the service area [THE REGULAR ELECTION IN APRIL 2009]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.50 mills in any calendar year.

<u>Section 3.</u> Except Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if the proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
