**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING JOHNNY C. WOMAC FOR HIS 27 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE
MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE**

WHEREAS, on December 18, 1979, Johnny Womac began employment with the Municipality of Anchorage. On February 8, 1982, Johnny began his career at Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility as a Wastewater Treatment Operator I at Point Woronzof Wastewater Treatment Facility; and, on March 9, 1983, he was promoted to Wastewater Treatment Operator II. In September 1983, he was AWWU's Employee of the Month for redesigning the removal of sludge from the clarifiers, and scum from the three scum collection boxes, thereby reducing the labor expenditures by approximately 35%, translating into approximately \$15,000 in man-hours; and,

WHEREAS, on July 12, 1983 Johnny transferred to the Eagle River Wastewater Treatment Facility; and, on June 18, 1985, he received a promotion to Treatment Plant Senior Operator. In 1987, he received the Alaska Water Management Association's Operator of the Year Award for the South Central Region. A promotion to Treatment Plant Operations Foreman occurred on June 15, 1988, followed by a promotion to General Foreman of the Eagle River Wastewater Treatment Facility on June 2, 2004. Johnny's responsibilities included overseeing the general operations and lab operations at the plant, dealing with the regulatory agencies, and ensuring the equipment and facility operated efficiently. He had the innate ability of a model supervisor with excellent administrative skills, which were demonstrated by his fair and direct relationship with his staff, combined with a willingness to adapt to new methods of treatment procedures; and,

WHEREAS, Johnny was honored by the Utility as the recipient of the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility Employee of the Year 2006 award, in recognition of being a key factor in maintaining high standards of excellence. Under Johnny's supervision, the Eagle River Wastewater Treatment Facility received numerous national awards, and he has made the Facility a showcase within the industry. On December 31, 2006, Johnny retired from the Utility having guaranteed, for the Municipality of Anchorage, an excellent wastewater treatment process that continues to achieve the highest environmental standards.
