A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ENCOURAGING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BANK AND/OR CREDIT UNION BRANCH WITHIN THE MOUNTAIN VIEW COMMUNITY.
