1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING AND
2 APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND TWO
3 DOLLARS (\$210,202) AS A FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FROM THE ALASKA
4 DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME (ADF&G) SOUTHEAST SUSTAINABLE SALMON
5 FUND TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL CIP FUND (FUND 401), OFFICE OF ECONOMIC
6 AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE CAMPBELL CREEK FISH AND
7 STREAMBANK REHABILITATION PROJECT.

10 WHEREAS, the Anchorage Municipality's *Salmon in the City* program receives federal
11 pass-through funds from the Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund and the Southeast
12 Sustainable Salmon Fund for projects to sustain salmon and fishing access along
13 Campbell Creek, and

14 WHEREAS, creek bank sections along Campbell Creek are showing signs of erosion and
15 bank trampling which reduces fish habitat, riparian vegetation and riparian function
16 important for salmon health; and

17 WHEREAS, these funds support construction of state-of-the-art bank stabilization and
18 restoration projects; and

19 WHEREAS, the project activities will provide information and knowledge transferable to all
20 creeks and watersheds within the Municipality, now therefore,

21 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**

22 **Section 1.** That the sum of Two Hundred Ten Thousand Two Hundred and Two Dollars
23 (\$210,202) in federal pass-through grant from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game
24 Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund is appropriated to the Areawide General Capital
25 Improvement Fund (Fund 401), Office of Economic and Community Development, for the
26 Campbell Creek Fish and Streambank Rehabilitation Project.

27 **Section 2.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and
28 approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

Subject: APPROPRIATION OF TWO HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND TWO DOLLARS (\$210,202) AS A FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME (ADF&G) SOUTHEAST SUSTAINABLE SALMON FUND TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL CIP FUND (FUND 401), OFFICE OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE CAMPBELL CREEK FISH AND STREAMBANK REHABILITATION PROJECT.

These funds support creek bank stabilization at selected sites where erosion is occurring along Campbell Creek. The completed work will result in restored creek banks; better angler/boating access and public safety; improved fish habitat and riparian function; and increased river bank stability. This project is part of the Municipality's overall Salmon in the City initiative which receives federal pass-through funding support from the ADF&G Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund.
