A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY FOR SUBMISSION TO THE TWENTY-FIFTH ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE IN SUPPORT OF NAMING THE STATE'S NEW PARKING GARAGE IN DOWNTOWN ANCHORAGE IN HONOR OF CAROLYN "LINNY" PACILLO.

WHEREAS, the new State Parking Garage under construction in downtown Anchorage north of the Atwood Building is a state parking facility; and

WHEREAS, to honor Linny Pacillo, her family, and the Municipality of Anchorage by designating the new State Parking Garage in her memory would serve to recognize this exceptional citizen and remind us all that we live in a representative democracy that honors its agents of change;
