A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5309 BUS AND BUS-RELATED EARMARK ALLOCATIONS GRANT AND APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$1,457,667) TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL FUND (485) FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF AN INTERMODAL TRANSIT FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage periodically applies for and receives Federal Transit Administration grants for capital, operational and other purposes in connection with providing public transportation and related facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly resolves:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Administration is authorized to accept a Federal Transit Administration FY2005 Section 5309 Bus and Bus-Related grant.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the sum of One Million Four Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$1,457,667) is hereby accepted and appropriated to Public Transportation Capital Fund (485) as a grant from the Federal Transit Administration to fund the design and construction of an intermodal transit facility at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Municipal Assembly of Anchorage.

 Accepting and appropriating a Federal Transit Administration FY2005 Section 5309 Bus and Bus-Related Earmark allocations grant Project No. AK-03-0067-00 that provides Federal capital assistance for an intermodal facility in the amount of one million four hundred fifty-seven thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$1,457,667).

The funds will be expended for the design and construction of an Intermodal Transit Facility at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art.

The 80% Federal share of this project is one million four hundred fifty-seven thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$1,457,667), consisting of FY 2005 Section 5309 Bus funds (E2005-BUSP-002) to be used for final design and construction of a Transit Intermodal Facility for the Anchorage Museum. This grant will fund the design and construction of an un-staffed transit station with heated sidewalks and covered boarding areas. The facility will be integral of the Museum Civic Campus, incorporated with modern lighting, highly visible attractive shelters with the technology to incorporate Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) bus arrival announcement systems, and potentially shared LED panel announcement boards. The facility could incorporate a covered bus bay.

The required local match in the amount of three hundred sixty-four thousand four hundred seventeen dollars (\$364,417) will be provided from the Project Management and Engineering Department's voter approved G. O. Bonds appropriated in the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area Capital Improvement Projects Fund (441). The matching funds will be expended for FTA grant eligible pedestrian walkway and roadway improvements on this Museum expansion project.
