WHEREAS, Food Bank of Alaska distributes over 6 million pounds of food to a statewide network of more than 300 non-profit agencies and organization serving individuals suffering from hunger; and

WHEREAS, by late spring of each year food bank stocks are rapidly depleting and the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) food drive helps to replenish their supplies; and


WHEREAS, on May 12, 2007 Letter Carriers in more than 10,000 cities and towns across the U.S. will be collecting non-perishable food donations, left by mailboxes and in Post Offices, and delivering the food to local community food banks, pantries, soup kitchens and shelters; and

WHEREAS, the efforts by members of the NALC, and the other volunteers for this event, is the largest one-day food drive in the nation and has resulted in the delivery of more than a half a billion pounds of donations over the past 15 years; and

WHEREAS, last year Anchorage Letter Carriers collected more than 50,000 pounds of food and this year they hope to collect more than 60,000 pounds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Anchorage Assembly applauds and supports the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual NALC Food Drive May 12, 2007 and encourages the citizens of Anchorage to demonstrate the spirit of giving and community through their generous donations.
