A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A MINOR AMENDMENT TO AN EXISTING RESTAURANT OR EATING PLACE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONDITIONAL USE IN THE B-3 DISTRICT FOR A NEW BEVERAGE DISPENSARY USE AND LICENSE NUMBER 4694 PER AMC 21.40.180 D.8, FOR HENRY'S GREAT ALASKAN RESTAURANT LOCATED AT 8001 OLD SEWARD HIGHWAY, VANS SUBDIVISION, BLOCK 1, LOT 10A; GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE OLD SEWARD HIGHWAY AND EAST 80th AVENUE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The minor amendment to an existing Restaurant or Eating Place Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a new Beverage Dispensary Use and License number 4694 per AMC 21.40.180 D.8 for Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant; located at 8001 Old Seward Highway, Vans Subdivision, Block 1, Lot 10A, generally meets the applicable provision of AMC 21.15.030.G.2 (a).

<u>Section 2</u>. This minor amendment will allow the transfer of ownership and location of Beverage Dispensary License #363 from Lamexicana, Inc. at 901 West 6th Avenue to Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant, located at 8001 Old Seward Highway as License number 4694.

Section 3. A beverage dispensary use and license will not change the size of the restaurant, the number of seats or required parking, hours of operation, or ratio of alcohol beverage sales to food sales. Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant has an approximate 6,688 square-foot dining room, lounge area plus the liquor storage/beer cooler within an 11,687 square-foot building. The dining and lounge area have one fixed bar. There are 150 fixed seats and 150 non-fixed seats. Required parking was satisfied at the time of the building permit. Hours of operation remain unchanged, 11:00 AM to 1:00 AM, Monday through Sunday, 365 days a year. Liquor sales represent 25 percent compared to 75 percent food sales.

<u>Section 4</u>. This change of alcoholic beverages from beer and wine to sale of all types of alcohol has no significant effect to the surrounding neighborhood and is a minor amendment.

<u>Section 5</u>. The subject conditional use permit amendment for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for Package Store per AMC 21.40.180 D.8 is subject to the following conditions:

1. A Notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the State District Recorder's Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of a final conditional use approval for the subject alcoholic beverages dispensary use in the B-3 District.

- 2. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted and to the conditions of approval as set forth in AR 2006-69.
- 3. Upon demand, the applicant shall demonstrate compliance with a "Liquor Server Awareness Training Program," approved by the State of Alaska Alcohol Beverage Control Board, such as or similar to, the program for Techniques in Alcohol Management (TAM).
- 4. A copy of the conditions imposed by the Assembly in connection with this conditional use approval shall be maintained on the premises.

<u>Section 6.</u> Failure to comply with the conditions of this conditional use permit shall constitute grounds for its modification or revocation.

<u>Section 7.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant has made application for a minor amendment to an existing alcoholic beverages conditional use in the B-3 District for a new beverage

dispensary use and license in accordance with AMC 21.40.180.D.

A valid alcoholic beverages conditional use for a restaurant/eating place use and license is currently in place at 8001 Old Seward Highway for Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant

(License 4579). Assembly Resolution AR 2006-69 was approved April 11, 2006. 8

Assembly Memorandum 270-2007, approved April 17, 2007, protested the transfer of ownership and location of Beverage Dispensary License number 363 from Lamexicana, Inc. at 901 West 6th Avenue, to Henry's of Anchorage, dba Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant at 8001 Old Seward Highway as license number 4694. The transfer was protested pending Assembly approval of the amendment to the existing conditional use.

Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant is located in a new 11,687 square-foot restaurant building, of which, 6,688 square feet contains the main dining and bar area. There is one fixed bar and 300 seats: (150 fixed seats and 150 non-fixed seats). There are 100 required parking spaces. The restaurant is open Monday through Sunday from 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. Twenty-five percent of total sales are alcohol compared to seventy-five percent food sales. The property is zoned B-3.

There do not appear to be any churches or schools within 200 feet of the subject site. The Anchorage Korean Open-Door Presbyterian Church building is located at 8220 Briarwood, some 900 feet to the southeast of the restaurant.

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AR 2007-117

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There are three beverage dispensary and four restaurant/eating place licenses with 1,000 feet of this restaurant. Approving this minor amendment for a beverage dispensary use in a restaurant and license will add a fourth beverage dispensary license.

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The conditions of approval, the number of tables, number of chairs, floor layout, site plan, the number of parking spaces, and the ratio of alcohol sales to food sales will remain unchanged from that which was approved by AR 2006-69.

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AMC 21.15.030.G.2 (a) requires ... "the Assembly, upon an express finding that the proposed modifications will have a significant effect on the surrounding neighborhood or on owners or occupiers of adjacent property...may determine that a public hearing is necessary. In such event the hearing shall be scheduled as soon as practicable after the matter first comes before the body for conclusion."

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Approval of this memorandum will determine that the proposed modifications are minor in nature and have no significant effect on the surrounding neighborhood.

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THE ADMINISTRATION BELIEVES THIS TO BE A MINOR AMENDMENT TO THE EXISTING CONDITIONAL USE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a new Restaurant/Eating Place use per AMC 21.40.180.D.8. for Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant; located on Vans Subdivision, Block 1, Lot 10A; site address being 8001 Old Seward Highway, meets the applicable provisions of AMC 21.50.020 and AMC 21.50.160.

Section 2. The subject conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the I-1 District for a new Restaurant/Eating Place per AMC 21.40.180.D.8. is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. A Notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the State District Recorder's Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of the final conditional use approval for a restaurant/eating place use in the B-3 District.
- 2. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted with this conditional use application, including the building plans except as modified by this approval.
- 3. This conditional use approval is for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a Restaurant/Eating Place Use per AMC 21.40.180.D.8. for an approximate 6,688 square-foot dining room, lounge area plus the liquor storage/beer cooler area within the 11,687 square-foot building located on Vans Subdivision, Block 1, Lot 10A. The dining and lounge are will have one fixed bar. Plans indicate 300 seats: 150 fixed seating and 150 non-fixed seating.

The use of the property by any person for the permitted purposes shall comply with all current and future Federal, State and local laws and regulations, including but not limited to, laws and regulations pertaining to the sale, dispensing, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the storage, preparation, sale, service and consumption of food. The owner of the property, the licensee under the Alcoholic Beverage Control license and their officers, agents and employees, shall not knowingly permit, or negligently fail to prevent the occurrence of illegal activity on the property.
- 7. A copy of the conditions imposed by the Assembly in connection with this conditional use approval shall be maintained on the premise at a location visible to the public.

<u>Section 3</u>. Failure to comply with the conditions of this conditional use permit shall constitute grounds for its modification or revocation.

<u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

Henry's of Anchorage, Inc. has made application for a restaurant beer/wine Alcoholic Beverage Conditional Use in the B-3 District for, Vans Subdivision, Block 1, Lot 10A per AMC 21.40.180 D.8 for a new restaurant, Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant.

The proposal is for a new restaurant beer/wine alcoholic beverage conditional use at 8001 Old Seward Highway, located at the southeast corner of Old Seward Highway and East 80th Avenue. A new 11,687 square-foot restaurant building will be constructed, and 6,688 square feet will contain the main dining and bar area. There will be one fixed bar, and 300 seats: 150 fixed seating and 150 non-fixed seating. Based on the total number of seating, 100 parking spaces are required.

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There are three beverage dispensary, and four restaurant/eating place licenses within 1,000 feet of the proposed restaurant. Approving this conditional use for a beverage dispensary in a restaurant would add a fifth beverage dispensary license. There do not appear to be any churches or schools within 200 feet of the petition site.

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Henry's Great Alaskan Restaurant will typically be open Monday through Sunday from 11:00 AM to 1:00 AM, 365 days a year, or as permitted by law. The petitioner estimates that 25 percent of his total sales will be for alcohol compared to 75 percent food sales. Employees will be trained in handling inebriated patrons, and will be trained in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's "Liquor Server Awareness Training Program."

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At the time this was prepared, the Anchorage Police Department and the Department of Health and Human Services did not provide comments. There are no personal or business taxes owing.
