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The current lighting system in the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts (ACPA) is out-dated, at risk of failure, and cannot be maintained or repaired because replacement parts are no longer available. A new lighting system is urgently needed in order for ACPA to continue reliably serving the needs of its patrons and performers.

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On March 13 (AR2007-51), the Assembly approved appropriation of \$125,000 from the Areawide General CIP Fund (Fund 401), Performing Arts Center Reserve Account, for the lighting upgrade project. On March 27 (AR2007-76), the Assembly also approved appropriation of a restricted contribution of \$315,000 from ACPA Inc. to the Performing Arts Center Reserve Account in support of this project. These amounts were determined based on engineers' estimates of the project cost. However, bids have now been opened and the lowest bid received exceeds the estimated cost. The additional \$189,000 appropriated here completes the funds required for award of the contract for this project (AR 2007-123).
