ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR NO. 2007–141

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING COMMUNITY ENDORSEMENT OF THE VALLEY RIVER CENTER AS THE PREFERRED SITE FOR CO-LOCATION OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES WITHIN THE TOWN CENTER AREA OF EAGLE RIVER AND PROVIDING ASSEMBLY SUPPORT FOR IMMEDIATE LEASE NEGOTIATIONS.

WHEREAS, in response to residents' recognition that the central business district of Eagle River needed a defined town core area with supporting elements, the Eagle River Central Business District Revitalization Plan was initiated and developed over a three-year period, with final adoption in 2003 as an element of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the urban design component of the adopted plan identifies the town core area of the central business district as the "Town Center of Eagle River" and recommends co-location of the various municipal functions in Eagle River within a single multi-functional facility to anchor this town center core area; and

WHEREAS, the library, social and local utility services, police substation, Emergency Operations Center, parks and recreation, and other municipal offices in Eagle River occupy leased space at various locations in the community; and

WHEREAS, the library lease will expire in September 2007, offering the need and opportunity to review and implement parts of the adopted plan; and

WHEREAS, Valley River Center consists of a four-building complex on Business Boulevard and Building A, former home to Rite Aid pharmacy until 1998 and the Alaska Marketplace until 2000, has remained empty since 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Valley River Center is located within the town center core area of the central business district identified in the adopted plan, with proximity to the transit center, Commons Park, outdoor pavilion and winter ice rink, mixed-use retail businesses such as cinema, grocery store, bowling alley, eateries, and has existing walkways, all of which make it ideally located for the co-location of municipal and public services, including the library; and

WHEREAS, until a recent change in ownership, full community support and municipal effort have been unsuccessful in securing space for municipal occupancy at Valley River Center; and

WHEREAS, new ownership of the Valley River Center and the immediate need to identify space for the library coincide to allow the municipality an opportunity to negotiate for leased space sufficient to accommodate co-location of other municipal services with the library at the Valley River Center,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. The Anchorage Assembly hereby formally recognizes the Chugiak-Eagle River Chamber of Commerce board's unanimous endorsement by resolution on April 24, 2007 of the Valley River Center as its preferred site and anchor facility for municipal services in the designated town center core area. The Anchorage Assembly further recognizes that community councils holding meetings through May have also passed similar resolutions endorsing this specific site.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Anchorage Assembly recognizes the support and hard work that municipal officials have given to the community in attempting to secure space for municipal offices in the Valley River Center over the past 7 or more years, including many officials in the present administration. The Anchorage Assembly acknowledges and appreciates the pledge and dedication of the Mayor's Office to act in accordance with the community's wishes.

Section 3. In recognition of the need to act timely so that the present opportunity is not lost, the Anchorage Assembly supports immediate efforts to negotiate for lease of space to the municipality in the Valley River Center. It is anticipated that the lease will be for a minimum lease term of 5 years, and a maximum lease term of 9 years, including the exercise of all options to extend. The library's current lease is for 12,500 square feet of space and the Office of Economic and Community Development is conducting needs assessments for the other municipal entities. It is anticipated that the combined facility be approximately 30,000 square feet, depending on completion of needs assessments. The lease shall be subject to Assembly approval.

Section 4. The Anchorage Assembly recognizes that by operation of law, site selection under AMC 21.15.015 is not invoked for leases less than 10 years. In lieu of site selection under AMC 21.15.015, the Anchorage Assembly relies on the community's assessment of this site through the Chamber of Commerce and the four Community Councils holding meetings before summer hiatus, designation of a town center core area in the adopted revitalization plan, the location of the Valley River Center within this designated town center core area, the specific attributes of the location including existing sidewalks, and the site's

 proximity to other core elements of urban design.

<u>Section 5.</u> The community and the Assembly having endorsed a specific site, neither the department of property and facility management nor the public purpose will be served by the solicitation of sealed competitive bids under AMC 7.20.020 or a request for competitive sealed proposals under 7.20.060. Lease approval by the Assembly shall be subject to specific waiver and exemption from the requirement of public solicitation under AMC 25.10.030B.7 by the department of property and facility management, under separate ordinance of the Assembly and supported by the circumstances outlined in this resolution.
