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17 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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19 Section 1. That SEVENTY SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX DOLLARS
20 (\$76,476) be appropriated from the Federal Seized and Forfeited Monies, short term interest for use by
21 the Anchorage Police Investigation Fund (257).
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23 Section 2. That FORTY TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY ONE DOLLARS
24 (\$42,981) be appropriated from the State Seized and Forfeited Monies, reimbursed cost for use by the
25 Anchorage Police Investigation Fund (257).
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
27 Section 3. That THIRTY ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN DOLLARS
28 (\$31,247) be appropriated from the Street Level Seized and Forfeited Monies, reimbursed cost for use by
29 the Anchorage Police Investigation Fund (257).
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
31 Section 4. That THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY ONE DOLLARS
32 (\$13,421) be appropriated from the Federal Seized and Forfeited Monies, reimbursed cost for use by the

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35 Section 5. That TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE
36 DOLLARS (\$280,375) be appropriated from the Federal Seized and Forfeited Monies, other fines and
37 forfeitures for use by the Anchorage Police Investigation Fund (257).

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4 **Subject:** Appropriation of Miscellaneous Seized and Forfeited Monies, Short Term Interest and
5 Reimbursed Costs for the Anchorage Police Department \$444,500
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8 The Anchorage Police Department requests appropriation of the sum of FOUR HUNDRED FORTY
9 FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$444,500) to the Police Investigation Fund (257).
10 This sum is from seized and forfeited monies, short term accrued interest, and reimbursed costs that have
11 been awarded to the Anchorage Police Department by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA)
12 through state and federal judicial proceedings as a result of joint DEA and Anchorage Police narcotics
13 interdiction operations.

15 The United States Attorney General is authorized under asset forfeiture provisions of the Comprehensive
16 Crime Control Act of 1984, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986, Title 21 of the United States Code, and
17 the Tariff Act of 1930 to transfer forfeited property. The transfer must be to local law enforcement
18 agencies that participate directly in seizure or forfeiture of the property. The Attorney General exercises
19 final authority over the official retention and transfer of forfeited property to local law enforcement and
20 establishes the guidelines and limitations for its use.
