IMMEDIATE RECONSIDERATION FAILED 6-26-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY HONORING RUTH MOULTON, SHIRLEY BRUNDAGE, AND AVIS CUPPLES AS SYMBOLS OF MANY PUBLIC ADVOCATES IN THE CREATION OF TOWN SQUARE.

WHEREAS, the untimely passing of Ruth Moulton on November 17, 2006 led the Assembly and community members to seek a method of commemorating her life and many contributions to the community of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly heard public testimony on June 12, 2007; and

 WHEREAS, the Assembly agrees with all who testified that Ruth Moulton's efforts on behalf of the community should be cherished and recognized; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly was also pleased and honored to hear public testimony and receive numerous other communications about other Alaska women, most prominently Shirley Brundage and Avis Cupples, and their work with the Anchorage Garden Club, to establish a Town Square in the heart of our city; and

WHEREAS, when internal areas, fixtures and features are overlooked and foreshadowed by honorary naming that favors naming only the larger public area, the consequences may include less recognition of the individual, less encouragement of community pride in the public place, and insensitivity to the contributions of others; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly seeks to meaningfully honor Ruth Moulton, Shirley Brundage, and Avis Cupples so that their efforts will be known and recognized as Town Square;

NOW THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1: Town Square should not carry the name of any single person or benefactor, but should otherwise reflect the contributions of the women who anchored this legacy, including Ruth Moulton, Shirley Brundage, and Avis Cupples. This public place shall be named "Town Square Park".

 Section 2: In honor of Ruth Moulton, Shirley Brundage, and Avis Cupples, the early efforts of the Anchorage Garden Club and the contributions of other citizens, the Assembly approves the designation of a garden area and cache an area within Town Square, to include placement of a commemorative narrative plaque describing the early history, public initiative, and individual efforts leading to the creation of Town Square.

Section 3. The Park and Recreation Department shall, as part of its current planning process, designate an element in Town Square Park and shall submit a conceptual design to the Assembly for approval within six months of the passage of this resolution.
