A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, APPROVING THE NORTHERN COMMUNITIES (SANITARY) SEWER EXTENSION AND PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT OF BENEFITED PROPERTIES AT TIME OF SERVICE CONNECTION.

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385 and AMC 19.80 mandate that when a main line extension will create, or has the potential of creating, any charge or assessment against the adjacent property, the extension may not be constructed unless the legislative body of each municipality through which the extension passes has approved the extension; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU), in conjunction with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and the Anchorage School District, plan to construct a section of sanitary sewer main in the Old Glenn Highway to serve Chugiak High School; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the sewer line will specially benefit and provide sewer service to twenty two (22) properties previously not benefited, and in doing so will create potential assessments against them; and

WHEREAS, at its February 6, 2008 meeting the AWWU Authority Board supported this resolution, now, therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. It is in the best interest of the community that said sewer main improvements proceed.


SECTION 2. AWWU shall keep an accurate account of all costs of the sewer main improvements.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> After the sewer main improvements have been completed and the costs of the sewer line approved, the Mayor shall cause the computation of all applicable assessment charges.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> At such time as the property cited on the attached assessment roll connects to the sewer main, the respective pro-rata assessment for the sewer line shall be levied in accordance with Municipal Codes and the Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff in effect at the time.

SECTION 5. A special assessment Collection Charge, as authorized in Rules Section 7.4 of the Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff, in effect at the time the assessment is levied, will be charged to those properties identified in this resolution.

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Northern Communities Sewer Extension



Benefited Properties at Time of Service Connection

AMC 19.80 and A.S. 42.05.385 require the Assembly's approval to construct a main extension where the extension will create charges or assessments against the adjacent properties. A public hearing is required prior to Assembly action.

The Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU), in coordination with the Anchorage School District (ASD) and the State of Alaska Department of Transportation, plan to construct a section of a sewer main to serve Chugiak High School. Construction of this main will make public sewer service available to twenty two (22) parcels.

Initially, all costs to construct the proposed sewer main extension shall be born by AWWU. When these newly benefited and previously unassessed parcels connect to the sewer main, AWWU shall recover a pro-rated share of its costs through the Levy Upon Connection assessment procedures as authorized by the current Municipal Codes and Utility Tariff.

Due to the Northern Communities sanitary sewer extension project AWWU presented AR 2007-292 and AM 773-2007 to the Anchorage Municipal Assembly for approval of estimated assessments to adjacent lots. The public hearing was scheduled for January 8, 2008.

Prior to the January 8, 2008 public hearing, questions were raised surrounding right of way acquisition impacts, prompting AWWU to reevaluate the selection of benefited properties. As a result, AWWU has removed (8) eight parcels which are not directly adjacent to the project and has added (8) eight other parcels along the alignment. Updated estimated assessment information is attached to this Assembly Resolution.

The properties benefiting from proposed construction, and subject to future assessments and charges, are identified on the updated proposed assessment roll, which is made part of the resolution carried by this memorandum. As each previously unassessed property seeks connection, the parcels' pro-rated share of assessable sewer main costs will be presented to the Assembly for confirmation of levy action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AWWU Tariff in effect at the time of connection.

Owners of benefited property were notified of the estimated project cost, and their individual property's estimated cost allocation by certified mail. Property owners were invited to a public meeting on November 28, 2007 with AWWU for further information and discussion. One (1) property owner attended this meeting. AWWU has notified all property owners affected by the changes addressed above.

The passage of this resolution will have no fiscal impact on any municipal owned parcels.
