1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED  
2 FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$258,145) FROM THE  
3 STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY  
4 MANAGEMENT, UNDER THE 2007 METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM (MMRS)  
5 GRANT PROGRAM, AND A CONTRIBUTION OF FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY  
6 DOLLARS (\$5,490) FROM THE AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101), ANCHORAGE FIRE  
7 DEPARTMENT 2007 OPERATING BUDGET, TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND  
8 (231), ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT, TO SUPPORT THE DEPLOYMENT OF AN  
9 ELECTRONIC PATIENT CARE REPORTING AND TRACKING SYSTEM, AND RELATED  
10 ENHANCEMENTS TO EXISTING BIO-SURVEILLANCE, HAZMAT INCIDENT RESPONSE, AND  
11 EMERGENCY INFORMATION MANAGEMENT AND NOTIFICATION CAPABILITIES.

13 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

14  
15 **Section 1:** That the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Eight Thousand One Hundred Forty Five Dollars  
16 (\$258,145) is appropriated from the State of Alaska, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency  
17 Management, under the 2007 Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Grant Program, to the  
18 State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Fire Department, to support the deployment of an  
19 electronic patient care reporting and tracking system, and related enhancements to existing bio-  
20 surveillance, HAZMAT incident response, and emergency information management and notification  
21 capabilities.

23 **Section 2:** That the sum of Five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$5,490) from the Areawide  
24 General Fund (101), Anchorage Fire Department 2007 Operating Budget, is appropriated as a  
25 contribution to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Fire Department, to support the  
26 deployment of an electronic patient care reporting and tracking system, and related enhancements to  
27 existing bio-surveillance, incident response, and emergency management information and notification  
28 capabilities.

30 **Section 3:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage  
31 Municipal Assembly.

**From:** Mayor

**Subject:** Appropriation of 2007 Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) federal pass-through grant in the amount of \$258,145 received from the State of Alaska, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and a contribution of \$5,490, from the Anchorage Fire Department 2007 Operating Budget, to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

The requested appropriation of 2007 Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) federal pass-through grant funds and contributed departmental operating funds will be used to support the Municipality of Anchorage Fire Department's Electronic Patient Care Reporting and Patient Tracking Project, to include the acquisition and deployment of software, professional services, and field deployed laptop computers to improve emergency medical care and documentation.

Approval of the appropriation will also provide additional funding to facilitate enhancements to the Municipality's existing bio-surveillance, HAZMAT incident response, and related emergency information management and reporting systems, which are designed to alert key personnel of imminent public health threats and events indicative of a potential or actual attack involving the use of weapons of mass destruction (WMD).

The period for performance is October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2009.
