1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUBMITTING TO
2 THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL
3 ELECTION ON APRIL 1, 2008, ONE OR MORE ADVISORY PROPOSITIONS ON
4 POTENTIAL ANCHORAGE POLICE OFFICER VERIFICATION OF IMMIGRATION
5 STATUS AND ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW.

8 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

10 **Section 1.** That an advisory ballot proposition in substantially the same form as
11 appears in Section 2 below shall be placed on the ballot and submitted to the qualified
12 voters of the Municipality at the regular municipal election of April 1, 2008.

23 federal law, be empowered by Anchorage municipal code to verify
24 immigration status during routine traffic stops and criminal law detentions?

1 with federal Immigration Control Enforcement to train and deputize
2 Anchorage police officers as agents in the enforcement of federal
3 immigration laws?

7 **Section 5.** The propositions contained in Section 2 and Section 4 of this ordinance,
8 presented to the qualified voters residing in the Municipality voting on the question in
9 the election of April 1, 2008, are each for an advisory vote only. Each question shall
10 advise the Anchorage Assembly of the voters' desire and opinion on the potential for
11 police officer verification of immigration status during routine traffic stops and criminal
12 law detentions, and on the potential for service by Anchorage police officers as agents
13 in the enforcement of federal immigration laws. No enabling legislation is enacted.

15 **Section 6.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
16 approval by the Assembly.
