AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT #3 REVISION TO PORT OF ANCHORAGE TERMINAL TARIFF NO. 6 TO ADD A RAILROAD CARS TARIFF RATE EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2008

WHEREAS, in 2006, the Port of Anchorage completed the first phase of its expansion project with the establishment of 7,000 feet of rail track connecting the Alaska Railroad main tracks to the Port; and

WHEREAS; this rail line is the start of what will be a Trailer-On-Flatcar load out facility on the east side of the Port, designed to provide an efficient Intermodal capability to all current and potential future port users, and, provide additional access for rail operations, for cargo movement in and out of the Port of Anchorage; and,

WHEREAS, in summer 2007, the Municipality of Anchorage and the Alaska Railroad signed a track use agreement which outlines responsibilities for operations and maintenance of this track; and,

WHEREAS, to date there is no published tariff established for realizing revenues from the use of that track, nor is there a mechanism to provide for security cost recovery for any secondary users that are not already participating in the established Port of Anchorage facility security users group; and,

WHEREAS, the Port Commission recommends the amendment to the Port of Anchorage Terminal Tariff No. 6 adding a Railroad Cars rate of \$45.00 per unit per day and a secondary user rate of \$17.00 per unit per day for security related expenses; now, therefore;

# THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Amendment #3 to the Port of Anchorage Terminal Tariff No. 6, Item No. 211 Railroad Cars rate \$45.00 per unit per day and Secondary User Security rate \$17.00 per unit per day.

<u>Section 2.</u> That, upon passage and approval by the Assembly, this ordinance shall be effective March 1, 2008.

# **PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

The railroad car tariff was created as part of the Port's expansion project. The rail will provide access to the barge docks for loading and unloading barge cargo and commodities from and unto rail cars. Until usage of the new rail establishes a record, the revenue estimates are based on projected initial barge dock activity and estimated military deployments. This tariff will fund the Port's rail maintenance and yield a return on investment.

### SUMMARY OF ECONOMIC EFFECTS

### PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The Port of Anchorage's Terminal Tariff No. 6 Amendment No.3 establishes a Railroad cars and engines charge of \$45.00 per unit per day. Also established is a Secondary Users fee of \$17.00 per unit per day for security-related expenses whenever a Secondary user requests ARRC services for movement of cargo and the Port Expansion Track is used. Until usage of the new rail establishes a record, the revenue estimates are based on projected initial barge dock activity and estimated military deployments.

CARS TARIFF RATE EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2008.

In 2006, the Port of Anchorage completed the first phase of its expansion project with the establishment of 7,000 feet of rail track connecting the Alaska Railroad main tracks to the Port. The double rail lines, referred to as the "Port Expansion Track," are the start of what will be a Trailer-On-Flatcar load out facility on the east side of the Port, designed to provide efficient Intermodal capability to all current and potential future port users. In summer 2007, the Municipality of Anchorage and the Alaska Railroad signed a track use agreement which outlines responsibilities for operations and maintenance of this track. However, to date there has been no tariff established for realizing revenues from the use of that track, or a capability to recover security charges for track use by users who are not already Port of Anchorage tenants. Therefore, in accordance with AMC 11.50.030 (B), the Anchorage Port Commission at its regular meeting of January 30, 2008 approved the a resolution recommending revision of Port of Anchorage Terminal Tariff No. 6 adding Railroad Cars, Tariff Item 211 to page 34 of the current tariff.

General Application of Tariff: Rates, charges, rules and regulations provided in this (a) terminal tariff apply to railroad cars, engines and any combination thereof on Port property on that track known as the "Port Expansion Track".

Prior to vacating the premises, railroad car/engine owner/operator shall ensure tracks are free of obstacles and in good operable condition. Failure to do so will result in the assessment of repair and clean-up charges.

(b) TARIFF RATE: railroad cars and engines will be assessed \$45.00 per unit per day.

Railroad cars and engines will be assessed an additional \$17.00 per unit per day for coverage of security-related expenses whenever a Secondary User requests ARRC services for movement of goods, and the Port Expansion Track is used.

NOTE: A Secondary User is defined as any user of Port of Anchorage facilities not already participating in shared payment of the established Port of Anchorage facility security contract, wherein a security tariff is already included.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO PORT OF ANCHORAGE TERMINAL TARIFF NO. 6 AND RECOMMENDING THAT THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ALSO ADOPT AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE ANCHORAGE TERMINAL TARIFF NO. 6.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code 11.50.030.C, the Anchorage Port Commission is charged with promulgating the Port's Terminal Tariff subject to approval of the Anchorage Municipal Assembly and the Federal Maritime Commission; and

WHEREAS, the tariff rate established for Railroad Cars and Engines for use of the Port of Anchorage Expansion Track will be \$45.00 per unit per day per this tariff amendment; and

WHEREAS, the tariff rate established for the Secondary User for Security is \$17.00 per unit per day for coverage of security-related expenses when not already participating in the shared security contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Port Commission resolves:

Section 1. That the Port Commission approves the following amendments to the Port of Anchorage Terminal Tariff No. 6:

Section 2. Definitions and Schedule of Charges, Item 211; the schedule is amended:

- 1. Railroad Cars and engines will be assessed \$45.00 per unit per day for Port Expansion Track.
- Secondary User for Railroad Cars and engines will be assessed an additional \$17.00 per unit per day for coverage of security-related expenses whenever a Secondary User requests ARRC services for movement of goods, and the Port Expansion Track is used.

Section 3. The amendment shall be effective March 1, 2008 upon approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
