**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS
3.97.025B. AND 3.97.030A. TO ADD SERVICE AREA BOARDS.**

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.97.025B. is amended to read as follows
(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

3.97.025 Criteria.

*** *** ***

B. *Public places under the jurisdiction of a parks and recreation board or commission.* In naming a public place, including a trail, [THAT IS] within the control and supervision of the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Department, the Girdwood Board of Supervisors, or the Chugiak-Eagle River Parks and Recreation Board of Supervisors, these additional factors shall be considered:

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.97.030A. is amended to read as follows
(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

3.97.030 Procedures.


A. *Citizen naming panel.* Preliminary action in naming a public place may be initiated by memorandum of the mayor or resolution of the assembly, identifying the proposed public place or individual, for referral to a citizen naming panel. If any request covers a public place in a municipal park, the request shall be referred to the parks and recreation commission or service area board with jurisdiction over the public place either before appointing the panel or by the panel after appointment. The four-member panel shall be appointed to proceed as follows:

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

**Subject: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE
SECTIONS 3.97.025B. AND 3.97.030A. TO ADD SERVICE AREA
BOARDS**

When the naming procedure in Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) was modified with AO 2007-95(S) in September 2007, it required a proposal to name a park or trail facility to go to the appropriate parks & recreation board or commission for a recommendation. AMC section 3.97.025 explicitly mentions the (Anchorage) Parks and Recreation Commission and the Chugiak-Eagle River Parks District Board of Supervisors. However, the Girdwood Board of Supervisors manages parks and trails within the Girdwood Parks Service District. This ordinance adds the Girdwood Board of Supervisors to the list of boards to consider park and trail facility naming proposals, and clarifies service area boards should offer a recommendation on the potential name for a park or trail facility within their management.
