In reviewing some of the Title 21 changes being developed by the Municipal Planning Department we noted a proposal to prohibit chronic animal noise for animals other than dogs and cats. This normally is a Title 17 function and we were concerned at the proposal to place it in Title 21. Upon meeting with representatives of both the Planning and the Health & Human Services Departments, the need for this proposal from Planning became evident.

When the Assembly considered the overall revisions to Title 17 a few years ago, there were many sections where our proposed language using "animal" was amended to read "dog and cat". In the majority of those sections the change made sense and was helpful.

When that change, however, was made to 17.10.015A, however, it had the unintended effect of limiting enforcement of chronic animal noise problems under Title 17 to only dogs or cats. Problems stemming from roosters, geese, mules and other vocal animals were not under the purview of Animal Control. Planning was trying to address that void.

We support Planning's efforts. We also believe, and they agree with us, that the best long term solution to this problem is to make a minor technical correction to Title 17 to clear up the current inconsistency.

A proposed ordinance to do just that is attached. The Animal Control Advisory Board unanimously recommended its approval at their last regular meeting.
