THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

11 Section 1. A 2007 Test Year Revenue Requirement Study, requiring an increase to the monthly recurring rates of the Anchorage Water Utility, effective January 1, 2009 and not to exceed 8.4%, is hereby approved for submission to 14 the RCA.

16 Section 2. A 2007 Test Year Revenue Requirement Study, requiring an 17 increase to the monthly recurring rates of the Anchorage Wastewater Utility. 18 effective January 1, 2009 and not to exceed 7.2%, is hereby approved for 19 submission to the RCA.

Section 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval 22 by the Anchorage Assembly.

Subject: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA

APPROVING SUBMISSION BY THE ANCHORAGE WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY ON BEHALF OF ANCHORAGE WATER UTILITY (AWU) AND ANCHORAGE WASTEWATER UTILITY (ASU) OF REVENUE REQUIREMENT STUDIES TO THE REGULATORY

COMMISSION OF ALASKA (RCA).

In accordance with Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) section 26.10.035, the Administration is submitting this ordinance for review and approval by the Assembly of submission by the Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) of 2007 test year revenue requirement studies for both the Anchorage Water Utility (AWU) and the Anchorage Wastewater Utility (ASU) to the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA).

AWWU is preparing the revenue requirement studies in accordance with the regulations and practices prescribed by the RCA and Alaska Statutes. The proposed across the board rate increases for 2009 do not exceed 8.4 percent for AWU and 7.2 percent for ASU. Final rate increases requested may be less than these currently estimated maximum rate increases, pending finalization of the revenue requirement studies. AWWU's proposed 2009 Operating Budgets include revenue from the proposed rate increases. Upon Assembly approval of AWWU's submission of these studies, AWWU intends to request interim and refundable rates effective January 1, 2009 from the RCA. The RCA then notices AWWU's requested rate increase to the public for comment. All rate changes are subject to the approval of the RCA.

29 Impacts of the Study

The Utility uses uniform rates for customer charges, unmetered usage charge per dwelling unit, metered volumetric rates, and meter charges. These basic rate components make up the individual customer bills. The proposed rate increases are applied across the board to all recurring rates. Changes in the most common monthly rates are:

The single-family residential water rate increases by \$3.07 per month in 2009 from the current \$36.50 to \$39.57 per month. The single-family residential wastewater rate increases by \$1.93 per month in 2009 from \$26.80 to \$28.73 per month in 2009. The combined water and wastewater bill for a single family residential customer increases from the current \$63.30 to \$68.30 in 2009. The combined water and wastewater rate increase as a percentage over 2008 for single family residential customers is 7.9% in 2009.

20 RCA Approval Required

Revenue from these rate increases is included in AWWU's budget. AWWU will file the 2007 test year Revenue Requirement Studies with the RCA upon Assembly approval of the proposed ordinance.

The RCA then notices the filing and proposed rate changes to the public and allows a thirty-day comment period. RCA Staff reviews the filing and makes a recommendation to the Commissioners whether to approve the filing or suspend it for further investigation. Then, the Commission renders a decision whether to approve or suspend the filing for further investigation within 45 days of the filing date. In the event the RCA suspends the filing for further investigation, AWWU will request interim refundable rates be made effective January 1, 2009 for both AWU and ASU.
