**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING BARBARA NIZIOL FOR HER 27 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE
MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE**

WHEREAS, in July 1980, Barbara Niziol began her initial employment with the Municipality of Anchorage as an Accounting Clerk I with the Finance Department, transferred to the Public Works Department in 1981 as an Accounting Clerk I and to the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) in 1983 as a Water Quality Technician I and was promoted through successive positions to Water Quality Analyst II; and,

WHEREAS, through her dedication and contributions to the Water Quality Section, AWWU has maintained an exemplary record of compliance with water and wastewater monitoring requirements required by operating permits and regulations, ensuring the public health and well-being of Anchorage's citizens, and protection of the environment; and,

WHEREAS, Barbara's commitment to extraordinary service was recognized with her selection as AWWU Employee of the Month in November 1986 and November 2007; and as a member of the 1991 AWWU Work Unit of the Year and runner-up 1991 MOA Work Unit of the Year (Support Services); and,

WHEREAS, Barbara was awarded the 1995 Laboratory Analyst of the Year Award by the Alaska Water Wastewater Management Association (AWWMA) South-Central Region, and was recognized in 1995 as part of the AWWMA Large Wastewater System Plant of the Year Award for her contributions with the lab staff; and,

WHEREAS, throughout her career, Barbara has enhanced her knowledge and abilities through continuing education and training, including earning a Master's Degree from UAA in Environmental Quality Engineering, a goal she pursued for several years by taking night classes while working at AWWU; and,

WHEREAS, Barbara chaired a committee to select a Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) for the Water Quality Section in 1994 and served thereafter as the section's LIMS Manager for implementation and ongoing management of the database; and was the lead in implementing other related projects such as electronic data reporting to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation and use of handheld data collectors; and,

WHEREAS, Barbara retired from AWWU employment effective November 30, 2007, having left the Water Quality Section with a strong foundation for fulfilling AWWU's Strategic Plan and with a strong record of accomplishment..


