 APPROPRIATING NINE THOUSAND EIGHTEEN DOLLARS (\$9,018) FROM A NATIONAL PARK SERVICE CHALLENGE COST SHARE PROGRAM GRANT TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANT FUND (241) FOR ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, GIRDWOOD VALLEY SERVICE AREA FOR IDITAROD NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION; AND CONTRIBUTING ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$164) FROM THE GIRDWOOD SERVICE AREA FUND (106) TO THE CATEGORICAL GRANT FUND (241) TO COVER ASSOCIATED GRANT ACCOUNTING SERVICES.

In 2006, the National Park Service (NPS) notified the Municipality of Anchorage that it would make available to the Municipality, Nine Thousand Eighteen Dollars (\$9,018) of FY 2006 Challenge Cost Share Program Funds for work on the Iditarod National Historic Trail in Girdwood. This amount will be matched with Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars (\$13,379) of in-kind services from the Girdwood Valley Parks and Recreation Operating Budget, Girdwood Valley Service Area Fund (106). The match will include the required contribution from the Girdwood Service Area Fund (106) to the Categorical Grant Fund (241) to cover associated grant accounting services of one hundred sixty-four dollars (\$164). The Girdwood Board of Supervisors supports taking part in this Challenge Cost Share Project and using funds from the Girdwood Valley Parks and Recreation budget for the required match.

 These funds will be used in the continuation of the work on the Iditarod National Historic Trail begun in 1996. The work to be completed with NPS matching grant will consist of trail maintenance and construction of the Iditarod National Historic Trail in Girdwood Valley Service Area. These recommended trail improvements have been identified in the Girdwood-Iditarod Trail Route Study that was adopted by the Municipality of Anchorage Assembly in Resolution 97-84, April 29, 1997. The Route Study was also adopted by the Girdwood Board of Supervisors, the Municipal Planning and Zoning Commission, and the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, which manages lands over which part of the route passes. The need for this project is identified in the Iditarod National Historic Trail Comprehensive Management Plan (1982) and the Anchorage Areawide Trails Plan (1997).
