A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A MINOR AMENDMENT TO TEMPORARILY RELOCATE AN EXISTING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONDITIONAL USE AND LICENSE NUMBER 1187 IN THE TRANSITION "T" DISTRICT, PER AMC 21.15.030.G, FOR THE UPPER ONE LOUNGE, LOCATED AT 5000 WEST INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ROAD FROM ROOM SA2310 TO ROOM LS2D22, ANCHORAGE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, T13N, R4W, SECTION 34; GENERALLY LOCATED AT STEVENS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. A conditional use permit and license Number1187 for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the Transition "T" District for a Beverage Dispensary Use per AMC 21.40.240D.5, for Upper One Lounge, located within the Anchorage International Airport, T13N, R4W, Section 34, has existed and operated continuously since circa 1955.

<u>Section 2</u>. This minor amendment will allow the temporary relocation and transfer of Beverage Dispensary License Number 1187 from Room SA2310 to Room LS2D22 within the same South Terminal while the concourse undergoes building renovations. At the conclusion of the renovations, the Upper One Lounge will return to its permanent location, Room SA2310.

<u>Section 3</u>. A new floor plan of Room LS2D22 shows a restaurant/lounge area containing fourteen (14) tables with four non-fixed chairs each, and nine (9) tables having two non-fixed chairs each, plus a bar and kitchen area. There is no change to the required parking or to business operating hours.

<u>Section 4.</u> This temporary change of location within the South Terminal has no significant effect to the surrounding neighborhood and is a minor amendment. This minor amendment generally meets the applicable provision of AMC 21.15.030.G.2 (a).

Section 5. The minor amendment is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. A Notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorder's Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of a minor amendment to an existing conditional use approval for a beverage dispensary use in the Transition

"T" District.

- 2. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted with this conditional use application.
- 3. This minor amendment to an existing conditional use approval is for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the Transition "T" District for a Beverage Dispensary Use per AMC 21.40.240D.5 to allow the temporary relocation of License Number 1187 to Room LS2D22 within the South Terminal of Stevens International Airport, located at 5000 West International Airport Road. At the conclusion of building renovations, the Upper One Lounge will return to its permanent location in Room SA2310..

<u>Section 6.</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.



Dear Ms. Fessenden:

You wrote me on October 29, 2007 to relinquish the liquor license for the Cloud Hoppers Bar (#2598) and request approval to relocate the Upper Lounge I Lounge within the Ted Stevens International Airport Terminal due to renovations. On December 3, 2007, you provided me with floor plans to illustrate this relocation approximately 75 feet down the terminal corridor.

Thank you for your assistance in handling this relocation matter.



A valid alcoholic beverages conditional use for a beverage dispensary use and license is currently in place for the Upper One Lounge License Number 1187. According to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, the license has operated continuously since 1955. The airport was outside of the geographic boundaries of the City of Anchorage in 1955, and the Greater Anchorage Area Borough was not incorporated until 1960. Thus, the

alcoholic beverages use is a legally nonconforming alcoholic beverages conditional use.

A new floor plan of Room LS2D22 shows a lounge area containing fourteen (14) tables with four non-fixed chairs each, and nine (9) tables having two non-fixed chairs each, plus a bar and kitchen area. Off-street parking exists at the airport which had incorporated the calculation for auxiliary use, such as restaurants and gift shops, which serve air travelers. There is no change in required parking or to operating business
