A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$113,440) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF ALASKA STATE TROOPERS AND APPROPRIATING TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$2,390) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW 2008 OPERATING BUDGET FUND (101) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL FUND (231) FOR ADMINISTERING THE ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska offered the Department of Law a grant for administration of the Anti-Gang Initiative Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law agrees to administer the Anti-gang Initiative Program to meet the goals of both state and local interests, provided State funding is available; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The sum of ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$113,440) is hereby appropriated from the State of Alaska, Division of Alaska State Troopers, to State Categorical Fund (231) for administration of the Anti-Gang Initiative Program in the Department of Law.

Section 2. The sum of TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$2,390) is appropriated from the 2008 Department of Law Operating Budget Fund (101) as a contribution to the State Categorical grants fund (231) for the purpose of paying IGCs.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.

13 The Department of Law is administering an Anti-Gang Initiative Program (Program).
14 The grant partially offsets the cost of the program. The attached resolution
15 appropriates the 2008 grant from State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety,
16 Division of State Troopers and a contribution from 2008 Operating Budget of the
17 Department of Law to fund the Program.

19 The Anchorage Police Department (APD) documented Anchorage's growing gang
20 problem. APD initiated a five-part program to aggressively prevent and crack down
21 on gang violence. Some of the new police officers added to the force over the last few
22 years are focused on the problem of gangs and related crimes of guns and drugs.
23 However, there is a growing backlog in the Alaska Court System in processing the
24 cases. According to the District Attorney for the State of Alaska, there are more than
25 2,500 felony cases awaiting disposition in Anchorage, including many gang cases.
26 Delays in processing mean the release of gang members into the community on bail.

28 Former U.S. Attorney, now U.S. District Court Judge Timothy Burgess proposed a
29 partnership between the Municipality of Anchorage and the Office of the U. S.
30 Attorney to help combat this problem. At Burgess' invitation, the Municipality
31 assigned the Program to the U.S. Attorney's office. The Program is a staff specially
32 trained in prosecution under federal laws, focusing primarily on gang-related crimes.
33 Gang members prosecuted under federal law typically are processed more quickly,
34 with more severe consequences, than under state law, removing gang members from

Anchorage streets.
