<u>Section 4</u>. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to furnish such additional information as the State of Alaska may require in connection with this application's program of projects.

<u>Section 5</u>. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for the financing of the Transit Planning Program.

 <u>Section 6</u>. That the sum of two hundred seventy thousand one hundred eighty-six dollars (\$270,186) is appropriated as a grant from the Alaska Department of Public Transportation and Public Facilities, when awarded, to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for the financing of the Transit Planning Program.

Under the provisions of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) Federal Transit Administration (FTA) planning grants are awarded to the State of Alaska. Following the grant award from FTA, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, develops a TORA which 'passes through' FTA funds to the Municipality of Anchorage. The amount of this TORA using the remainder of the 2007 Section 5303 apportionment for the transit planning program is \$270,186. The required local match for the 2007 program is \$67,547 and is to be funded from the Public Transportation Department's 2007 and 2008 operating budget in the amounts of \$57,110 and \$10,437, respectively.
