WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage appreciates all of the diverse and hardworking members of its boards and commissions; and

WHEREAS, the missions of the Municipality's boards and commissions require an assortment of skills, backgrounds, and professional qualifications; and

WHEREAS, Municipal boards and commissions serve as an excellent opportunity for the public to actively participate in important community decisions; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage is one of the most multicultural, and diverse communities in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage is home to the largest population of Alaska Natives, and one of the largest Native American populations of any community in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage ranks third in America for community per capita population of Pacific Islanders and Native Hawaiians (behind only Honolulu and Sacramento), ranks 19th per capita for Asians, ahead of Chicago, Minneapolis and Washington, D.C. and ranks second in the country in the number per capita of people who are two or more races; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic community members of all races represent 7% of Anchorage's population and African-Americans represent another 7% of Anchorage's population; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 U.S. Census indicated that approximately 30 percent of the Municipality of Anchorage population is comprised of a diverse representation of racial and ethnic minorities; and

1	WHEREAS, in 2007 46 percent of students in the Anchorage School District came				
2	from ethnically diverse backgrounds, compared to 13 percent in 1976; and
