10 WHEREAS, the Municipality's *Salmon in the City* program receives federal funds from the
11 Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund and the Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund for
12 projects to sustain salmon, restore creek banks and provide for fishing access along
13 Campbell Creek; and

15 WHEREAS, gauging station information is essential for monitoring stream flows, assessing
16 water quality and understanding the creek hydrology in order to sustain salmon in the
17 Campbell Creek watershed and to support the popular recreational fishery; and

19 WHEREAS, information from the gauging station will provide valuable information in
20 support of other municipal functions including flood hazard and watershed management;



23 WHEREAS, this project is being implemented in cooperation with other state, federal, and
24 local agencies and community groups; now therefore,

26 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**

28 **Section 1:** That the sum of Sixty Thousand Ninety Six dollars (\$60,096) is appropriated as
29 a federal pass-through grant from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game Southeast
30 Sustainable Salmon Fund to the Areawide General CIP Fund (Fund 401), Office of
31 Economic and Community Development, for the Little Campbell Creek Gauging Station.



Subject: APPROPRIATION OF SIXTY THOUSAND NINETY SIX DOLLARS (\$60,096) AS A FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME (ADFG) SOUTHEAST SUSTAINABLE SALMON FUND TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) FUND (FUND 401), OFFICE OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE LITTLE CAMPBELL CREEK GAUGING STATION.

This appropriation provides funds to collect, review and summarize data from an existing gauge along Little Campbell Creek. Gauge stations provide valuable information to assess stream flows and water quality and better understand creek hydrology. This information will help resource managers sustain salmon resources and the popular recreational fishery in the Campbell Creek watershed. The information can also support the functions of the City's flood hazard and watershed programs. The project is part of the Municipality of Anchorage's Salmon in the City initiative which receives federal pass-through funding support from the ADFG Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund. The project will be implemented in collaboration with the ADFG Sport Fish division and the Anchorage Waterways Council.
