**Subject:** Appropriation of a Supplemental Grant Award for the Provision of Public Health Preparedness and Response for Bioterrorism.

The Department of Health and Human Services has received a supplemental grant award from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services for Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000). The total grant award is \$870,000. The period of the grant is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

The supplemental funds will partially fund a Nurse Epidemiologist that will provide research, design, implementation and evaluation of population based surveillance activities for infectious disease outbreaks and control and other public health threats or emergencies and supports epidemiological investigations of public health threats or emergencies and advises on appropriate control measures and mass dispensing strategies.

Under the terms of the grant, staff will provide the following services:

- plan and implement pandemic flu, infectious disease outbreak and bioterrorism preparedness and response measures;
- conduct training needs assessment(s), develop and implement training and marketing plans, and coordinate training of DHHS staff related to public health preparedness and response to bioterrorism, infectious disease, and other public health threats and emergencies; and
- promote participation by local health care providers in various trainings offered through the Alaska Public Health Training Network.
