10 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-SIX DOLLARS (\$285,796) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231), FOR AN AIR QUALITY PUBLIC AND BUSINESS AWARENESS EDUCATION CAMPAIGN IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

This appropriation will provide the funding necessary to continue air quality education and outreach to Anchorage motorists in the public and business communities. No matching funds are required. The period of this grant is from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

Over the past ten years the Department of Health and Human Services has used air quality advertising and outreach to encourage use of engine block heaters, alternative transportation and other measures to reduce carbon monoxide and air toxics emissions from personal vehicles. During the year, the campaign will increase emphasis on promoting bicycle commuting and telecommuting as alternatives to driving. Most of the funding from this appropriation will be directed to professional advertising services and outreach targeted toward commuters and their employers in the business community. Funding for this project originated from Federal highway and transportation monies programmed in the AMATS Transportation Program.
