A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5309 BUS AND BUS-RELATED EARMARK ALLOCATIONS GRANT AND APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$238,000) TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL FUND (485) AS ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PHASE 2 CONSTRUCTION OF A PARATRANSIT OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE CENTER.

Phase 1 included the construction of the 11,000 square foot AnchorRIDES paratransit administration building built adjacent to the old People Mover Shop and was scheduled for substantial completion by May 30, 2008. This new operations and remodeled maintenance facility will improve the efficiency of the transportation service for senior citizens and people with disabilities. In 2007 Phase I was competitively bid as a Design/Build contract and awarded to Corvus Construction to construct the new AnchorRIDES administration building and begin remodel of the old People Mover shop with a new fire sprinkler system. Not all the necessary work was included in the contract due to budget constraints. Federal funding is now available and it is in the Municipality's best interest to complete the remodel of the old shop which will result in cost savings and more efficient operations of the AnchorRIDES program.

This appropriation provides funding for Phase 2 to further improve the shop space for AnchorRIDES. The old People Mover Shop is approximately 22,386 sq. ft. and has five bays one of which includes a wash bay located at the west end. Phase 2 is an open bid contract and will utilize these funds to complete remodels to the old People Mover shop to be occupied by the AnchorRIDES division. The funds to be expended for Phase 2 will allow for rehabilitation of 21,000 square feet of an existing maintenance space that is adjacent to the new AnchorRIDES Administration building. The remodel work is essential to relocating the AnchorRIDES maintenance function into the old People Mover Shop that is approximately 30 years old. The proposed work includes upgraded heating; air exchange and vehicle exhaust system, lighting, relocation of shop equipment, and wash bay improvements. These improvements are necessary for safety to meet industry standards and to reduce utility costs.

The required local match of fifty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$59,500) will be provided from appropriated and voter approved 2008 General Obligation Bonds.
