A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REVISING THE APPROVED 2008 SOLID WASTE SERVICES OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS TO REFLECT RECENT ASSEMBLY APPROVAL OF RATE INCREASES AND COMMUNITY RECYCLING INITIATIVES.

WHEREAS, Solid Waste Services is comprised of two separate utilities — the Refuse Collection Utility which collects refuse from commercial and residential customers in the former City of Anchorage collections area, and the Solid Waste Disposal Utility which operates the Anchorage Regional Landfill, and transfer stations in Girdwood, mid-town Anchorage (Central Transfer Station) and at the landfill. The Solid Waste Disposal Utility also operates a fleet of vehicles to haul refuse from the transfer stations to the Anchorage Regional Landfill for final disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly supports community recycling initiatives and intends to implement new programs beginning in 2008; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2008 the Assembly approved AO 2008-62(S) authorizing and approving rate increases effective August 1, 2008 for the Solid Waste Services Refuse Collection Utility and the Solid Waste Disposal Utility Operating and Capital Budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Services 2008 Approved Operating and Capital Budgets must be revised to provide for the rate increases;

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the 2008 Solid Waste Services Operating and Capital Budgets are revised as follows:
