Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000) FROM THE MOUNTAIN VIEW WEED AND SEED PROGRAM TO THE MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (261), FOR TRANSLATION OF THE ANCHORAGE COMMUNITY EMERGENCY ADVOCACY RESOURCES BOOKLET, IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

This appropriation will provide the funding necessary to translate the Anchorage Community Emergency Advocacy Resources booklet also known as the 'Little Blue Booklet' into languages that may include Spanish, Tagalog, Samoan, Korean, and Hmong.

Over the past five years, the Department of Health and Human Services has collaborated with the Anchorage Police Department (APD) to produce and distribute the Anchorage Community Emergency Advocacy Resources booklet. This booklet is distributed by APD officers to all victims of domestic violence. The 'Little Blue Booklet' includes victims' rights information that is required by AS 18.65.520 to be delivered to all victims of domestic violence orally and in writing. This booklet is also produced for widespread distribution by the Department of Health and Human Services to the public and service providers. Translation of the 'Little Blue Booklet' into different languages will provide victims rights and resource information to all victims of crime whose primary language may be Spanish, Tagalog, Samoan, Korean, or Hmong.

Funding for this project originated from the Weed and Seed Program, which is funded through a federal grant from the United States, Department of Justice, Community Capacity Development Office and is administered in Mountain View by the Anchorage Community Land Trust. The Weed and Seed strategy is to engage the community in crime prevention and control as well as community redevelopment. Translation of the 'Little Blue Booklet' is a key element in the Weed and Seed Program community engagement strategy.
