
1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING

9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

11 **Section 1.** That the sum of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-
12 Two Dollars (\$114,332) is hereby appropriated from the U.S. Environmental Protection
13 Agency to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), for the Air Quality Program to
14 conduct air quality monitoring for benzene in the Department of Health and Human
15 Services.

Subject: APPROPRIATION OF ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$114,332) FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR THE AIR QUALITY PROGRAM TO CONDUCT AIR QUALITY MONITORING FOR BENZENE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (DHHS).

This appropriation will provide the funding necessary to perform monitoring of benzene, polyaromatic hydrocarbons and other toxic air pollutants for one year beginning in the fall of 2008. The EPA solicited proposals for air toxics projects from communities around the U.S. and awarded DHHS this grant of \$114,332 through a competitive process. The EPA has also agreed to provide an additional \$69,976 worth of "in-kind" laboratory services. DHHS will be using the EPA laboratory to analyze most of the samples collected in the study. The two-year grant period begins May 1, 2008 and ends April 30, 2010.

The purpose of this project is to measure the concentrations of benzene and other toxic air pollutants in Anchorage air prior to the implementation of new EPA rules, which will limit the amount of benzene in gasoline. DHHS intends to solicit grant funding for a follow-up monitoring study to measure benzene concentrations in the air after the new gasoline rules take effect to evaluate the effectiveness of the rules in reducing these concentrations. These new rules are expected to take effect sometime between 2012 and 2016. Past monitoring suggests that the benzene levels in Anchorage air are among the highest in the U.S.
