APPROPRIATION OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ANIMAL CONTROL DONATION ACCOUNT, MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261), TO AMEND A GRANT TO THE ALASKA SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS FOR THE PROVISION OF LOW-COST FELINE SPAY/NEUTER SERVICES THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

In 1998, the Administration established the Animal Control Donation Account as a restricted contributions account. Assembly approval is required for all expenditures from this account. Over the years, the Animal Care and Control Center has received and deposited to this account numerous generous public donations intended to benefit animals

in the community.

On August 14, 2007, the Assembly approved (AR 2007-186) a grant award from this donation account in the amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500) to fund a low-cost spay/neuter program for cats, "Fix a Feline," operated by the Alaska Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Alaska SPCA) to curb the population of stray cats in the Municipality.

Due to the success of the program in its early months of operation, a number of private contributions, totaling Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), have been received by Alaska SPCA toward further funding of the Fix a Feline program. Based on this demonstration of community interest and support for the program, on July 24, 2008, the Animal Control Advisory Board unanimously recommended the grant award be amended to add Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) from the Animal Control Donation Account, for a total grant award amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

The Alaska SPCA is an independent local 501(c)3 non-profit organization. Since the Alaska SPCA's founding, they have sterilized approximately 97,000 cats (over 7,000 through their mobile clinic van). These services are directly supportive of the efforts of the Animal Care and Control Center to help control the population of unwanted animals.
