## NOW, THEREFORE, the ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

The staffing requirement under Section 1, Condition B.1. and the Section 1. hours-of-operation restriction under Section 1, Condition E.1. of AR 93-123 (As Amended) shall not apply as conditions of the conditional use permit for this location.

Section 2. Except for lifting Conditions B.1. (on-premise staffing requirement) and E.1. (hours-of-operation restriction), the conditional use approval for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-2A District for a Package Store use and license per AMC 21.40.150 D.12, for Brown Jug, Inc., dba Downtown Wine and Spirits; located at 930 West 5th Avenue, as set out in AR 93-123 (As Amended) remains unchanged.
