
Grant, for Pedestrian Bridge Repairs, Girdwood Trails

The accompanying Assembly Resolution is for the appropriation of \$100,000 in grant funds from the State of Alaska Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation, Alaska Trails Initiative to the Girdwood Valley Service Area (406) for design and construction of repairs to the pedestrian bridge crossing the Alaska Railroad on the Girdwood Trail. This 1980's-era trail continues to be popular with the citizens of Girdwood and Anchorage as well as visitors who enjoy the 'Bird-to-Gird' trail. The trail is consistent with the Anchorage Areawide Trails Plan (1997) and is regarded as a key trail and an important link in the Girdwood Commercial Areas and Transportation Master Plan, 2001.

The Girdwood trail from Seward Highway to Crow Creek Road was built by the Alaska Department of Transportation in 1981, and a maintenance agreement was established with the Municipality. The existing trail and bridge surfacing, through wear and aging, is damaged to the point of being hazardous to users. This grant represents a cooperative effort by Anchorage Parks & Trails, Girdwood Board of Supervisors Trail Committee, and Girdwood Parks Department to acquire state funding to address hazards on the trail's pedestrian bridge.

Expenditures are approved from August 20, 2008 to August 31, 2010. The following budget is presented for Assembly information:
