A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE 2009 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, WHICH CONSTITUTES THE APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), THE AMERICAN DREAM DOWNPAYMENT INITIATIVE (ADDI) AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG). THIS RESOLUTION SEEKS TO APPROPRIATE THE ANNUAL ENTITLEMENT GRANTS FROM HUD, PROGRAM INCOME AND RECAPTURED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$1,833,994) OF 2009 CBDG ENTITLEMENT, ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$135,594) OF PROJECTED CDBG PROGRAM INCOME FUNDS, EIGHT HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$823,134) OF 2009 HOME ENTITLEMENT, ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$181,660) OF PROJECTED HOME PROGRAM INCOME/RECAPTURED FUNDS, TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$10,298) OF 2009 ADDI ENTITLEMENT, AND NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) OF 2009 ESG ENTITLEMENT, AND TO APPROPRIATE SAID FUNDS TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241).

WHEREAS, extensive research and analysis was used to complete the 2008-2012 Municipality of Anchorage Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), which is the basis for a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage will submit its annual application and *Housing* and Community Development 2009 Annual Action Plan (2009 Action Plan) of the Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), outlining the program of activities to be undertaken with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds; and

32 33 WHEREAS, throughout the development of said application and the 2009 Action Plan, the Municipality of Anchorage actively sought participation of residents and representatives of lower income Anchorage neighborhoods, including community councils; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 Action Plan was made available to the public on August 1, 2008, public testimony on said application and 2009 Action Plan was heard before the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission on May 14, 2008, a second public hearing was held on August 13, 2008, and written comments on the plan were accepted through August 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the HAND Commission made a recommendation to the Assembly regarding the 2009 Action Plan on September 10, 2008.

### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Assembly adopts the 2009 Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan as the general basis of a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods and the application for applicable federal grants.

Section 2. That the subject grants from HUD for the PY2009 allocation of CDBG funds in the amount of one million eight hundred thirty-three thousand nine hundred ninety-four dollars (\$1,833,994), projected CDBG Program Income funds in the amount of one hundred thirty-five thousand five hundred ninety-four dollars (\$135,594), HOME funds in the amount of eight hundred twenty-three thousand one hundred thirty-four dollars (\$823,134), projected HOME Program Income/Recaptured funds in the amount of one hundred eighty-one thousand six hundred sixty dollars (\$181,660), and ADDI funds in the amount of ten thousand two hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$10,298), is hereby appropriated, with final approval expected from HUD in February 2009, to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241), Department of Neighborhoods, PY2009 funding contingent on final approval by HUD expected in February 2009.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the subject grant from HUD for the PY2009 allocation of ESG funds in the amount of ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) is hereby appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241), Department of Health and Human Services, contingent on final approval by HUD expected in February of 2009.

Section 4. That the allocation of said grant funds will be based on the activities outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, and in the 2009 Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. Accounting information is outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, Attachment A.

<u>Section 5.</u> That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

ADOPTION OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 2009 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (2009 ACTION PLAN) AND APPROPRIATING PROGRAM INCOME/RECAPTURED FUNDS AS WELL AS PROGRAM YEAR (PY) 2009 ENTITLEMENT GRANTS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), AMERICAN DREAM DOWNPAYMENT INTIATIVE (ADDI), AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG) TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2009 ACTION PLAN.

The purpose of the attached resolution is to adopt the 2009 Action Plan and appropriate program income and PY 2009 entitlement funds. The 2009 Action Plan constitutes the Municipality of Anchorage's application for U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement funds for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG). The 2009 Action Plan is the second of five annual action plans as part of the 2008-2012 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan.

The 2009 program year begins on January 1, 2009. The 2009 Action Plan will be submitted to HUD by November 15 after approval by the Assembly, and HUD may review the 2009 Action Plan for 45 days before final approval. PY 2009 entitlement funds identified in this document are based on projected grant awards as HUD has not yet released the actual 2009 entitlement award amounts. Consequently, all PY 2009 entitlement amounts are contingent on actual awards as announced by HUD, and actual award amounts may require return to the Assembly for appropriation of additional funds.

The 2009 Action Plan outlines an agenda of activities to be undertaken during the program year to address needs of the Municipality's lower-income residents and identifies potential resources available in the community to undertake these activities. The 2009 Action Plan was developed by the Department of Neighborhoods (DoN) in collaboration with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission, other organizations and private citizens. CDBG, HOME, and ADDI grants are managed by DoN of the Office of Economic and Community Development. The ESG grant is managed by DHHS.

Consistent with federal regulations, a discussion for input on the 2009 Action Plan was held in advance of the draft, during the HAND Commission's regularly scheduled May 14th

meeting. The availability of the draft 2009 Action Plan for public comment was noticed through the Anchorage Daily News and through an electronic mailing on August 1st. Comments were taken in-person during a public hearing on August 13th, and written comments were accepted through August 31st. All comments were considered in the final draft of the 2009 Action Plan and in the HAND Commission recommendation; responses to public comments are included in the Plan. Copies of the final drafts of the Plan are included as Attachments B and C to this Memorandum.

The Department of Neighborhoods, Office of Economic and Community Development, requests approval of the attached resolution to approve the 2009 Action Plan and appropriate program income and CDBG, HOME, ADDI and ESG entitlement funds. Details on the sources and uses for each of these grants are included in the tables below. Additional descriptions of each activity are included in the 2009 Action Plan, Appendix C.
